Question on the hillside behind Phase III, Hillgrove Village of Discovery Bay

Ms. Amy YUNG notified this Council that she will raise the following enquiry at the Tourism, Agriculture, Fisheries and Environmental Hygiene Committee meeting to be held on 28 November this year:

“ Some residents reflected that apart from slope maintenance works (10SW-B/CR150), road construction seemed to be conducted on the slope behind Phase III, Hillgrove Village of Discovery Bay (DB) as well. I am concerned that the road construction along the slope will cause safety problems. Thus, I hope to invite the representatives of the Civil Engineering and Development Department, the Buildings Department and DB Services Management Limited (the management company) to attend the meeting and explain the following:

1. What works are being conducted on the slope? Are they slope maintenance or road construction or both?
2. If a road or buildings are being constructed on the slope, has the Building Authority received the relevant documents and plans and considered it safe to carry out the works and granted a written consent?
3. Currently, how many dangerous slopes exist in the Islands District and how many of those have yet to comply with the Dangerous Hillside Orders served? ”
