

Question on the hillside behind Phase III, Hillgrove Village of Discovery Bay
(Paper TAFEHC 66/2016)

Written reply of Discovery Bay Services Management Limited

As City Management is not responsible for the concerned site work, we consider that it will not be appropriate for us to attend. However, we have relayed the message to HKR (in particular to questions 1 & 2 raised by Ms Amy Yung) and their replies are as follow:

“ The site work behind Phase III, Hillgrove Village of Discovery Bay is a natural terrain migration project to protect the slopes against damage or landslide. As requested by Geotechnical Engineering Office of Civil Engineering Development Department, a rock fall barrier for public protection is being installed, followed by reinstatement of landscape feature. The work details (including hoarding plan) have been approved by Buildings Department and consent to commencement of works was obtained by Buildings Department on 6th June. All works are target to be completed in late November. Relevant papers and photos have also been displayed at entrance of the hoarding area for public viewing. There is no road work nor any building development included in this project.

HKR have also informed by City Management that since March this year, they have been communicating with Hillgrove Village Owners' Committee on the subject in each committee meetings throughout the construction period. Joint site walk along access to the construction area was also made to clarify the concerns raised by some committee members. Information about the progress and revised programme has been disseminated to the committee from time to time as required. ”
