Question on a damaged LPG pipe at Caperidge Drive, Discovery Bay

Ms Amy YUNG notified this Council that she would raise the following enquiry at the Tourism, Agriculture, Fisheries and Environmental Hygiene Committee meeting to be held on 27 March this year:

“ On 11 February this year, the LPG pipe at 13-27 Caperidge Drive was damaged and temporarily out of service, and the residents were required to turn off the control valve and use the standby gas pipe to maintain hot water supply.

As such, I would like to invite representatives of the Electrical and Mechanical Services Department, Discovery Bay Services Management Limited and San Hing (LPG) Company Limited to attend the meeting and respond to the following:

1. What was the cause of the incident, and whether it was caused by negligence or lack of inspection?
2. Which party should be responsible for the cost of repair and corrosion protection works?
3. When will the pipe repair and corrosion protection works be completed? ”
