

Progress Report of the Committees under the Sai Kung District Office

This paper briefs the Sai Kung District Council (SKDC) on the work of the committees under the Sai Kung District Office (SKDO) in 2023-24.

Sai Kung District Fight Crime Committee

2. Sai Kung District Fight Crime Committee (SKDFCC) is committed to implementing work on fighting crime and maintaining law and order at the district level, offering advice to the Government on crime and law enforcement in the district, organising district fight crime publicity activities, enhancing public awareness of crime prevention and strengthening partnership between the Police and the community. The current term of SKDFCC is from 1 January 2023 to 31 March 2024. SKDFCC conducted four meetings in 2023. The 5th meeting will be conducted in February 2024. Two working groups were established under SKDFCC, namely “Fight Crime Working Group” and “Anti-drug Working Group”, which organised a total of fifteen publicity and education activities, deepening the public’s knowledge of crime prevention and raising anti-drug community awareness on various fronts.

3. As regards the overall crime situation in the district, SKDFCC noted that the number of crime cases reported to Tseung Kwan O District, Sai Kung Division and Marine East Division in January to December 2023 were 4 675 (an increase of 957 cases when compared with the same period in 2022), 454 (an increase of 93 cases when compared with the same period in 2022) and 11 (a decrease of 2 cases when compared with the same period in 2022).

Sai Kung District Fire Safety Committee

4. Sai Kung District Fire Safety Committee (SKDFSC) was set up to provide advice for the Government on fire safety matters and to organise fire prevention publicity and education activities that promote fire safety and raise residents' awareness in this regard. The current term of SKDFSC is from 1 January 2023 to 31 March 2024. The Committee conducted five meetings during this term. During the meetings, representatives of Fire Services Department and the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department briefed the committee on the fire incident statistics in Tseung Kwan O and Sai Kung areas and the hill fire statistics in country parks in the Sai Kung District respectively. The members provided views on fire incidents and the strengthening of fire safety measures to relevant departments. This year, SKDFSC

organised four district events to enhance public awareness of fire safety.

Area Committees

5. The major functions of area committees (ACs) are to advise the Government on issues of concern to the area and promote public participation in district affairs to support effective governance at district level. ACs also organise community involvement activities and implement government-funded initiatives based on district needs. The current term of Sai Kung Area Committee, Tseung Kwan O (North) Area Committee and Tseung Kwan O (South) Area Committee is from 1 January 2023 to 31 March 2024 and the new term is from 1 April 2024 to 31 March 2026, with members from different strata of the community. During their tenure of office, the three ACs each convened four meetings. The fifth meeting of Sai Kung Area Committee will be convened on 1 March 2024, in which members expressed their views on district matters, including issues arising from scheduled district works, ancillary transport facilities, water sports safety, facilities maintenance, environmental hygiene, illegal parking, construction of rain shelter etc. In addition, they organised different community building activities, for example, Youth Bazar cum Mini Concert, district cleaning campaign, embracing community inclusion, etc. for public engagement.etc.

Sai Kung District Youth Development and Civic Education Committee

6. The Sai Kung District Youth Development and Civic Education Committee (SKDYDCEC) and the Sai Kung District Office (SKDO) organise, through funds allocated to district organisations and schools, a wide range of activities for the Hong Kong youth aged between 6 and 29, to foster their all-rounded development and to enhance national and civic education. The current term of SKDYDCEC runs from 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2025, consisting of local personalities appointed by the Director of Home Affairs and self-recommended youths. SKDYDCEC held four meetings in 2023-24, over which 105 summer activities, 15 local youth activities and 6 territory-wide/cross-district youth development activities were organised with various local communities and schools, covering volunteer services, leadership training, sports and recreation, mental health, etc. The working group on youth development programmes under SKDYDCEC also organised “Sai Kung Tseung Kwan O Outstanding Youth Commendation Scheme 2023-24”, which recruited a total of 37 participants through recommendations by secondary schools, tertiary institutions and universities in the district to take part in activities such as “Talks on the History and Cultural Heritage of Sai Kung”, “Unicorn Dance”, “Newly Emerged Sports - Dodgeball”, “Hiking Training” and “Two-day, One-night Leadership Training Camp”, with the aims of providing participants with training and hands-on opportunities to realise their potentials, as well as cultivating their sense of belonging towards the community. The civic education working group organised a variety of

creative activities, including “Card Game on Improving Governance at the District Level” to introduce the structure and services of improved governance at the district level, “Sai Kung District Civic Education Drama Tour” themed on core civic values of “Respect”, “Responsibility”, “Love” and “Inclusiveness” and knowledge of national education, and “Basic Law Orienteering Fun Competition” for the promotion of the Constitution, the Basic Law and national security education.

Sai Kung Youth Ambassador

7. SKDO continued to implement the “Sai Kung Youth Ambassador” Programme by organising various activities and trainings last year, such as leadership training programme, art creation, sports experience and career planning visit, to broaden the horizons of the youth, provide exposure to innovation and technology, enhance their confidence, improve their communication skills and foster their understanding about the community.

Sai Kung District Youth Community Building Committee

8. The Sai Kung District Youth Community Building Committee (SKDYCBC) was established with the aim of engaging more young people in public affairs, enhancing their interaction and trust with the Government and providing a platform for Members to express their views on district affairs such as district minor works and improvement works. SKDYCBC comprised of district personalities and self-nominated young people appointed by the Director of Home Affairs with effect from 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2025 has convened a total of three meetings since its establishment. Members have offered valuable advice in relation to district minor works and beautification, including beautification of the concrete external walls at the junction of Po Ning Road and Tin Chau Road, beautification of the retaining walls at Yau Yue Wan, beautification of the external walls of Sai Kung Tseung Kwan O Government Complex, beautification of the open space adjacent to Sheung Ning Playground (under the flyover), construction of a hiking trail from Ma Yau Tong to Lam Tin Park and festive lighting decorations in Sai Kung District, etc.

Sai Kung District Building Management Promotion Committee

9. The membership of the Sai Kung District Building Management Promotion Committee (SKDBMPC) comprises representatives of different building management organisations in Sai Kung District. SKDBMPC aims at building and promoting a platform for mutual communications for sharing the experience, knowledge and information about building management and reflecting views to relevant government departments. The current term of SKDBMPC is from 1 April 2023 to 31 March 2025. Members have provided various suggestions about building management affairs for

the Government and organised community involvement activities in 2023-24, including a total of five rounds of Building Management Workshops, two rounds of Sai Kung District Building Management Professional Legal Seminars and Building Management Roving Exhibitions of Easy Roll Banners.

10. Details of the activities organised by the committees above in 2023-24 are listed in **Annex** for SKDC's information. Comments from SKDC Members are welcomed.
