

**Memorandum of Sai Kung District Council**  
**Progress Report of Sai Kung District Council**  
**Housing and Environment Hygiene Committee**

The fourth meeting (2009) of the Sai Kung District Council Housing and Environment hygiene Committee (HEHC) was held on 28 July 2009. The major issues discussed at the meeting were summarized as follows:

**Tseung Kwan O Sewerage Works and Ma Yau Tong Sewerage Works**

2. Members noted the details of Tseung Kwan O sewerage works and Ma Yau Tong sewerage works to be launched by the Drainage Services Department (DSD). They supported these two items of works.

**Request Hong Kong Housing Authority to Bear the Responsibility for the Soakage Problem of External Wall at Tong Ming Court**

3. The committee endorsed the above motion and urged HD to give a written reply in relation to its refusal to accept the consultant company's infrared detection of external wall soakage report which was hired by the Owners' Corporation of Tong Ming Court.

**Strong Opposition to Establish a Karaoke Bar at Hau Tak Shopping Centre under the Management of The Link**

4. The Chairman said that the Liquor Licensing Board had issued a six-month license to the Karaoke Bar at Hau Tak Shopping Centre which enabled the shop to sell alcoholic drinks to midnight. The Committee agreed that the Chairman would follow up residents' comments.

**Request the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD) to Conduct a Thorough Improvement on Public Toilet Facilities at Tseung Kwan O, Sai Kung**

5. Members urged the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD) to enhance its management of public toilet facilities. As for toilet facilities in community halls, its management would be followed up by the District Management Committee (DMC).

**Enhancement of Pest Control and Publicity Education in the District**

6. Members noted that FEHD had enhanced pest control and public education in the

district.

**Anti-mosquito Campaign (Phase II) in Sai Kung District in 2009**

7. Members noted the Anti-mosquito Campaign (Phase III) in Sai Kung District in 2009 by the Food and Environment hygiene Department (FEHD).

**Request for Installing Noise Barriers at Housing Estate in Tseung Kwan O Adjacent to Busy Highways As Soon As Possible**

8. The Committee opined that members' views would be gathered and proposals to increase noise barriers along sections of road would be listed out before making a submission to the Environmental Protection Department (EPD).

**Traffic Noise along Tseung Kwan O Tunnel Road**

9. The Highways Department (HyD) said that as the traffic volume at downhill section of the road was too heavy, it would be much convenient to seal off that section of road for paving noise insulation material during long vacation. It was planned to conduct the road works at downhill section in Christmas holiday.

**Request for Proper Handling of Noise Nuisance Caused by the Youth Loitering at Night in Kin Ming Estate**

10. The Housing Department (HD) said that publicity had been enhanced and the number of night patrols had been increased too. The situation was seen to have improved and would be kept on following it up.

**Request for Solving Congestion Problem to Access between Choi Ming Shopping Centre and Kin Ming Estate As Soon As Possible**

11. The representatives of the HD and property management agency briefly introduced the Committee about the study report and opined that there was no need to have another access at this stage. The Committee was not satisfied with the result and urged HD to keep on monitoring the situation. The statistics of pedestrian flow would be provided at every meeting.

**HEHC Urging the Government to Build a Cover on Pavement along Mau Yip Road, Po Fung Road, Yuk Nga Lane**

12. Sai Kung District Office (SKDO) said that SKDO would collaborate with the Transport Department (TD) to follow up the issue at inter-departmental committee

meetings.

**Request for HD and the Police to Solve Problem of Object Dropping from Height at Kin Ming Estate, TKO**

13. HD said that two sets of monitor known as “Sky Eye” had been ordered and it was expected to have them installed at Kin Ming Estate in mid-September. The Committee asked HD to provide detailed statistics of object dropping from height at local public housing estates, which also illustrated types of object.

**Request for Solving Stray Dogs Problem in TKO and Asking Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD) to Solve Stray dogs Problem in TKO**

14. Members noted the job of Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD) in catching stray dogs at Sai Kung.

**Statistics on Environmental Hygiene Service in Sai Kung District**

15. Members noted the document about statistics on environmental hygiene service in Sai Kung District.

**Recyclable Waste Collection Station in Boon Kin Village**

16. The Committee said that DMC would keep on following the issue up.
