

Sha Tin District Council

Report on the Meeting of District Facilities Management Committee
held on 22 April 2008

- (1) Members endorsed 8 District Facilities Works Projects proposed by the Leisure and Cultural Service Department (LCSD) and Sha Tin District Office (STDO) and the reservation of \$3,070,000 for the above projects.
- (2) Members endorsed the funding application for “Customer Liaison Group Seminar” submitted by the Working Group on the Management of Recreation and Sports Facilities. The approved amount was \$13,160.
- (3) Members noted the minutes of meeting of the Working Group on the Management of Recreation and Sports Facilities and Working Group on the Management of Community Halls and Libraries and endorsed the membership lists of the above two working groups and the Working Group on District Facilities Works. Members also endorsed the following recommendations of the Working Group on the Management of Community Halls and Libraries:
 - (a) For the first round of community hall application, the minimum number of participants for Ping Pong and Badminton will be lowered as follows:
 - (i) the number of participants should not be less than 8 for Lung Hang Estate Community Centre, Heng On Estate community, Lee On Community Hall and Mei Tin Community Hall,
 - (ii) the number of participants should not be less than 5 for the remaining 8 community halls that are smaller in size.
 - (b) trial run for extending opening hours of Lee On Community Hall, Lek Yuen Community Hall and Sun Tin Wai Community Hall from 9 a.m. to 7 a.m..
 - (c) the above (a) and (b) recommendations would be on trial for 6 months starting from October 2008 and would be reviewed afterwards.

- (4) Members noted the reports on the management of recreational and sports facilities, weekly cleansing programme of public swimming pools and the service and management of public libraries in Sha Tin submitted by LCSD.
- (5) Members noted the report on the management of community halls in Sha Tin submitted by STDO.
- (6) Members noted the adjustment in the proposed estimates of 2008/2009 District Minor Works funding as follows:
