

Sha Tin District Council

Report on the Meeting of District Facilities Management Committee  
held on 19 August 2008

---

- (1) Members noted the reply of Education Bureau to the question on the use of vacant school premises as community hall and endorsed the following motion with a vote of 27 in favour and 1 abstention:

“The District Facilities Management Committee of Sha Tin District Council is disappointed at the Education Bureau in altering the use of Ho Fai Primary School without consulting Sha Tin District Council and objects to the use of Ho Fai Primary School for vocational training in support of the Qualifications Framework. This Committee strongly urges the relevant government departments to set up an inter-departmental working group (including representatives from District Councils and local community) to follow up the arrangement on using vacant school premises as community hall and report regularly to the District Council.”

- (2) Members endorsed the meeting schedule of the Committee in 2009.
- (3) Members endorsed the district facilities works proposals for 2008/2009 and the funding arrangement submitted by the Working Group on District Facilities Works. They also endorsed a reservation of \$2,149,000 and \$159,000 for the financial years of 2009-10 and 2010-11 respectively for spending on the construction of basketball court at A Kung Kok Fisherman Village in these two financial years.
- (4) Members noted the reply of Sha Tin District Office to the question on the air conditioning system of community halls.
- (5) Members noted the reply of Home Affairs Department to the question on the district minor works block vote.

- (6) Members noted the minutes of meeting of the Working Group on District Facilities Works.
- (7) Members noted the reports on the Management of Recreation and Sports Facilities in Sha Tin and the Service and Management of Public Libraries in Sha Tin submitted by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department.
- (8) Members noted the report on the management of community halls in Sha Tin submitted by Sha Tin District Office.
