

SHA TIN DISTRICT COUNCIL

Report on the Culture, Sports and Community Development Committee meeting  
held on 23 October 2008

---

- (1) Members endorsed the funding application for Lunar New Year Lantern Carnival submitted by Sha Tin Inhabitants Association and Sha Tin Activity Committee and the total approved amount was \$61,560.
- (2) Members endorsed the funding application for “Sha Tin West One Area Carnival” submitted by Sha Tin West One Area Committee and the total approved amount was \$49,990.
- (3) Members endorsed the funding application for “Sha Tin West Two Area New Territories West One Day Tour” submitted by Sha Tin West Two Area Committee and the total approved amount was \$40,481.
- (4) Members noted the replies of Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD), Transport Department and Sun Hung Kai Properties Charitable Fund to the question on Sha Tin City Art Square.
- (5) Members noted the reply of LCSD to the question on the outstanding leisure and cultural facilities projects of the former Municipal Councils.
- (6) Members endorsed the following motion with a vote of 34 in favour, 0 against and 0 abstention:

“The Culture, Sports and Community Development Committee of Sha Tin District Council strongly requests LCSD to expedite the development of Sports Centre, Community Hall cum Library at Sha Tin Area 14B and urges the Government to provide the construction timetable for the eight outstanding leisure and cultural facilities projects of the former Municipal Councils in Sha Tin District. ”

- (7) Members noted the reply of LCSD to the question on the development of

recreational area between Kam On Court and Chung On Estate.

- (8) Members endorsed the following motion with a vote of 28 in favour and 1 abstention:

“To maximize the use of land resources and accede to the request of residents, the Culture, Sports and Community Development Committee of Sha Tin District Council requests LCSD to start the preliminary works of the vacant sites next to Kam On Court and Chung On Estate and at Ma On Shan Area 86 as soon as possible in order to open for public use and continue to upgrade the above three vacant sites to park standard.”

- (9) Members noted the minutes of meeting of all working groups under the committee.
