Report on the Meeting of the Health and Environment Committee  
held on 6 November 2008

- (1) Members discussed the paper on “Hawker Licensing Policy Review” submitted by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (FEHD).
- (2) Members discussed the paper on “Elderly Medical Coupon Pilot Scheme” submitted by the Department of Health (DH) and endorsed the following provisional motion put forward by Dr. Elizabeth Quat with a vote of 24 in favour:  
  
“The Health and Environment Committee of Sha Tin District Council strongly requests the Government to increase the value of medical coupon to \$1,000 annually and lower the age limit to 65.”
- (3) Members discussed the paper on “Flu Vaccine Assistance Scheme” submitted by DH.
- (4) Members endorsed the funding application of Working Group on Health City and Medical Services and the approved amount was \$45,460.
- (5) Members endorsed the funding application of Working Group on Environment Protection and the approved amount was \$160,000.
- (6) Members noted the replies from Leisure and Cultural Services Department, FEHD and DH to the question on the quality of toilet rolls in public toilets.
