Report on Education and Welfare Committee Meeting  
held on 30 December 2008

- (1) Members noted proposal of Education Bureau (EB) on the future use of CCC Kei Kok Primary School premises. After discussion, members endorsed the following motion with a vote of 23 in favour and 3 abstentions:

“The Education and Welfare Committee of Sha Tin District Council does not object to the applications of Hong Kong Schools Sports Federation, Hong Kong Schools Dance Association and Hong Kong Schools Music and Speech Association for using CCC Kei Kok Primary School premises as association centre. However, the Committee strongly requests EB to first consider applications from those schools in Sha Tin district that are in need and intended to use the school premises.”

- (2) Members noted the replies of EB, Civil Service Bureau and Hong Kong Examinations and Assessment Authority to the question on the certification of education qualification.
- (3) Members noted the minutes of meeting of the Working Group on the Care of Under-privileged Community and Family Violence, Working Group on the Education and International Day of Disabled Persons and Working Group on Welfare of Senior Citizens. They also endorsed the updated member list of the Working Group on Welfare of Senior Citizens.
