

Sha Tin District Council

Report on the Meeting of the Health and Environment Committee
held on 8 January 2009

- (1) Members noted the paper on “Sha Tin Transfer Station – extension of refuse transfer service” submitted by Environmental Protection Department (EPD).
- (2) Members discussed the paper on “Closed-circuit television pilot scheme against flytipping - proposed pilot location at Tai Po Road (Piper's Hill Section)” submitted by EPD and endorsed the following provisional motion with a unanimous vote of 29 in favour:

“The Health and Environment Committee of Sha Tin District Council supports in principal the Closed-circuit television pilot scheme against flytipping at Tai Po Road (Piper's Hill Section) proposed by EPD and requests the Department to increase resources to strengthen the monitoring of other black spots through mobile and irregular enforcement in order to achieve deterrent effect.”
- (3) Members noted the paper on “Carbon Audit Programme” submitted by the Hong Kong Productivity Council.
- (4) Members noted the replies from Food and Environmental Hygiene Department, Department of Health, Electrical and Mechanical Services Department and Hospital Authority to the question on water dripping from air-conditioners and water-cooled air-conditioning systems.
- (5) Members noted the reply from Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department (AFCD) to the question on tree conservation and safety. Since no representative was sent by AFCD to attend the meeting, the chairman suggested postponing the question for discussion in the next meeting.
- (6) Regarding the question on nuisance caused by wild monkeys, the chairman announced that the question would be arranged for discussion in another meeting as the member who raised the question had left.

(Post-meeting note: The Chairman agreed to put forward the question for

discussion in Sha Tin District Council meeting on 22 January.)

- (7) Members noted the minutes of meeting of the Working Group on Cleanliness and Hygiene of Sha Tin District, Working Group on Environmental Protection and Working Group on Health City and Medical Service.
