

Sha Tin District Council

Report on the Meeting of Traffic and Transport Committee
held on 3 March 2009

- (1) Members discussed the paper on Sha Tin New Town - Stage II – Trunk Road T4 submitted by Civil Engineering and Development Department (CEDD) and Transport Department (TD). CEDD and TD stated that both departments would continue to closely monitor the traffic condition in Sha Tin and consult Sha Tin District Council (STDC) again about T4 Trunk Road project at appropriate time.
- (2) Members discussed the paper on improvement on road safety at Tai Po Road (near Kam Shan Country Park) submitted by TD and endorsed the proposal of TD with an unanimous vote of 24 in favour.
- (3) Members discussed the study report on “Further Development of Sha Tin as a Cycling City” submitted by the Working Group on Traffic and Transport Study and endorsed the study report and report summary with an unanimous vote of 25 in favour.
- (4) Members endorsed the proposed estimates under Expenditure Head 7 of 2009/2010 as follow:

<u>Working Group</u>	<u>Reserved Funding</u>
Working Group on Road Safety	\$110,000
Working Group on Traffic and Transport Study	\$130,000

- (5) Members noted the replies from TD and CEDD to the question on accidents in cycling track subway under the Lion Bridge at Shing Mun River Promenade.
- (6) Members noted the reply from TD to the question on the walkway cover of outdoor bus terminal and passed the following motion with a vote of 23 in favour:

“The Traffic and Transport Committee of STDC strongly requests TD and the relevant departments to construct a walkway cover at a suitable area at the transport interchange of Sha Tin University Station as soon as possible for the convenience of the public and to relieve their sufferings on rainy and sunny days.”

- (7) Members noted the replies from TD and Kowloon Motor Bus (1933) Company Limited (KMB) to the question on the route of No. 82K bus route.
- (8) Members noted the replies from TD, KMB, City Bus Limited and New World First Bus Services Limited to the question on the routes of No. 680 and 682 bus routes.
- (9) Members noted the reply from Mass Transit Railway Corporation Limited to the question on fare dodging along East Rail of MTRC.
- (10) Members noted the “Report on the Feasible Route of Underground Cable at Chik Tai Lane, Mei Tin Road and under the Flyover at Tai Po Road” submitted by the CLP Power Hong Kong Limited.
- (11) Members noted the progress report submitted by TD.
- (12) Members noted the minutes of meeting of the Working Group on Road Safety and Working Group on Traffic and Transport Study and endorsed the updated member list of Working Group on Traffic and Transport Study.
