# 西貢區議會財務及行政委員會 二〇〇三及〇四年度工作報告

西貢區議會財務及行政委員會(下稱「本會」)二〇〇三年度第一至第三次會議,已分別於二〇〇三年四月二十五日、六月二十六日及八月十二日舉行。此外,二〇〇四年度第一次及第二次會議亦已分別於二〇〇四年一月十四日及一月十九日舉行。會上討論的主要事項撮錄如下:

## 二〇〇三年度工作報告

### 二〇〇三至〇四年度西頁區議會撥款分配

2. 委員備悉二〇〇三至〇四年度西頁區議會的總撥款額爲10,000,000元,其中20,000元已直接用於「十八區區議會支持心連心對抗肺炎大行動」活動。此外,由於二〇〇三年年初非典型肺炎問題日趨嚴重,區議會主席建議取消二〇〇三年度的西貢區龍舟競渡,並把預留給該項活動的資源撥予「對抗肺炎」及「西貢海傍廣場竣工誌慶暨旅遊推廣」活動。區議會全體會議及後通過是項建議。

## 揀選足球隊代表西貢區參加香港足球總會丙組七人足球賽

- 3. 本會收到西貢區體育會及西貢將軍澳文化康樂體育協會分別就申請代表西貢區參加香港足球總會(足總)(2003-04)丙組聯賽而提交的計劃書。
- 4. 經討論後,本會通過提名西貢將軍澳文化康樂體育協會的球隊代表西貢區參加上述賽事。本會同時通過致函足總,申請准許多派一隊球隊(西貢區體育會代表隊)參賽。委員希望該兩隊球隊可同時爲本區爭光。不過,足總回覆表示不接納上述申請。

### 暫停接受區內各文康團體及社會服務機構提出撥款申請

5. 西貢區議會在非典形肺炎爆發期間承諾撥出大量資源協助推動 社區清潔和舉辦抗疫活動,本會經過二〇〇三年度第一及第二次會議 審批後,已經批出西貢區議會二〇〇三年度的大部分撥款。有鑑於 此,西貢區議會通過,在本會二〇〇三年度餘下的會議中,除特定居 民組織舉辦的旅行活動及由預留撥款資助的活動,暫停接受區內各文 康團體及社會服務機構提出撥款申請。

# Memorandum for Sai Kung District Council Progress Report of Sai Kung District Council Finance and Administration Committee (2003 and 2004)

The first to third meetings (2003) of the Sai Kung District Council (SKDC) Finance and Administration Committee (FAC) were held on 25 April, 26 June and 12 August 2003 respectively. Besides, the first and second meetings (2004) of the SKDC FAC were held on 14 January and 19 January 2004 respectively. The major issues discussed are summarized below:

### 2003 Progress Report

### Disbursement of SKDC Funds (2003-04)

2. Members noted the total amount of fund granted for 2003-04 was \$10,000,000, among which \$20,000 had been directly used on the "Operation Unite" Campaign supported by the 18 districts. As the problem of atypical pneumonia was getting increasingly serious in early 2003, the Chairman of the SKDC suggested cancelling the 2003 Sai Kung Dragon Boat Race and having the resources ear-marked for the event allocated to 'Fighting Against Atypical Pneumonia' and 'Sai Kung Hoi Pong Square Project Completion Celebration cum Tourism Promotion'. His proposal was later on endorsed by the plenary meeting of the SKDC.

# Selecting Soccer Teams to Represent Sai Kung District to Participate in Hong Kong Football Association (HKFA) Third Division Seven-a-side Soccer Match

- 3. The FAC received proposals submitted by the Sai Kung District Sports Association and the Sai Kung Tseung Kwan O Cultural, Recreation and Sports Association in application for representing Sai Kung District to participate in the 2003-04 HKFA Third Division League.
- 4. After discussion, the FAC endorsed to nominate the soccer team of the Sai Kung Tseung Kwan O Cultural, Recreation and Sports Association in representing Sai Kung District to participate in the aforesaid competition. The FAC also endorsed to seek approval from the HKFA for sending one more soccer team (the team from Sai Kung District Sports Association) to take part. Members wished that both teams would be able to bring credit to the district. However, the HKFA had turned down

the aforesaid application its reply.

# Temporary Cessation of Accepting Funding Applications Lodged by Local Cultural and Recreational Associations as well as Social Services Organizations

5. During the outbreak of SARS, the SKDC undertook to allocate a large amount of resources for promoting community cleaning and holding viral combating activities. After considering the funding applications at the first and second meetings, the FAC had already had most of the 2003 SKDC funds allocated. As such, the SKDC endorsed that the FAC would temporarily cease to accept funding applications lodged by various local cultural and recreational associations as well as social services organizations for holding activities, with the exception of picnics organized by specified residents' organizations and activities sponsored by ear-marked funds.

### 2004 Progress Report

#### Election of Chairman and Vice-chairman

6. Mr. LAU Wan-hei and Mr. Shek Chi-keung were elected new Chairman and Vice-chairman respectively during the first meeting (2004) of the FAC

### Applications for DC Funds

7. The SKDC and FAC examined a total of 404 applications for DC Funds during 2003-04. Details are as follows:
