

SHA TIN DISTRICT COUNCIL

Report on the meeting of  
Culture, Sports and Community Development Committee  
held on 16 December 2010

---

(1) Members endorsed:

- (i) the formation of Working Group on Screening of Funding Application (Ad-hoc), under which there were two subgroups with convenors as follows:

Culture, Sports and Recreation	Mr YIU Ka-chun
Community Development and Community Organisation	Mr CHING Cheung-ying

- (ii) the following three DC funding applications with a total amount of \$583,500, which were submitted by the Organising Committee of Sha Tin Festival:

<u>Activity Name</u>	<u>Applied Amount</u>
(a) Sha Tin Festival – Fun Fest	\$52,200
(b) Model Display of Sha Tin Sightseeing Spots	\$65,600
(c) Sha Tin Festival Spring Lantern Carnival	\$465,700

- (iii) the funding application for Proposed Sha Tin District Free Entertainment Programme of Leisure and Cultural Services Department (“LCSD”) submitted by LCSD. Since the applied amount was \$834,900, which exceeded \$250,000, the application had to be recommended to the Finance and General Affairs Committee (“FGA”) for consideration;
- (iv) the funding application for Sha Tin District Recreational and Sports Activities Programme from April 2011 to March 2012 of Leisure and Cultural Services Department submitted by LCSD. Since the total applied

amount was \$5,790,300, which exceeded \$1 million, the application had to be recommended to the District Council via FGA for consideration; and

- (v) the funding application for Sha Tin District Public Libraries Promotion Activities from April 2011 to March 2012 submitted by LCSD and the total amount was \$51,634.

(2) Members noted:

- (i) the paper on Survey on Intangible Cultural Heritage in Hong Kong submitted by LCSD;
- (ii) the reply of LCSD to the question on the Swimming Pool Monthly Pass Scheme;
- (iii) the joint reply of LCSD, Civil Aviation Department and Hongkong Post to the question on the Celebration Activities of 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary on Flying in Hong Kong;
- (iv) the reply of LCSD to the question on the provision of heated pool facilities at Ma On Shan Swimming Pool, and the following motion was passed with an unanimous vote of 25 in favour:

“The Culture, Sports and Community Development Committee of Sha Tin District Council strongly urges LCSD to provide heated pool facilities at Ma On Shan Swimming Pool in response to the demand of the community”;

- (v) the papers on Briefing on 2011 Sha Tin Lunar New Year Fair and Briefing on 2011 Sha Tin Che Kung Festival Fair submitted by Food and Environmental Hygiene Department; and
- (vi) the minutes of meetings of the Working Group on Promotion of Civic-mindedness and Youth Affairs, Working Group on Community Involvement by Women and Working Group on Mid-Autumn Festival.
