

SHA TIN DISTRICT COUNCIL

Report on the meeting of  
Culture, Sports and Community Development Committee  
held on 24 February 2011

---

(1) Members endorsed:

- (i) the formation of Working Group on Ma On Shan Mining History (Ad-hoc), which would operate from 1 April to 31 August 2011 with Mr YEUNG Cheung-li as the convenor;
- (ii) the reservation of \$834,900 and \$50,980 under Expenditure Head 1 (Cultural Affairs) for Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LSCD) to organise free district entertainment programmes and public library promotional activities respectively, and the proposed funding applications from community organisations totalling \$1,765,397 recommended by the working group on the screening of funding applications (Working Group);
- (iii) the reservation of \$5,783,300 under Expenditure Head 6 (Recreation and Sport) for the LSCD to organise recreational and sports activities, and the proposed funding applications from community organisations totalling \$1,328,969 recommended by Working Group;
- (iv) the proposed estimates totalling \$4,200,000 under Expenditure Head 8 (Festive Celebrations) with reserved funding for “Christmas and New Year Lighting”, “Dragon Boat Race”, “Reunification, National Day and Celebration Activities”, Mid-autumn Festival Activities” and “Large Scale District Activities”;
- (v) the reservation of a total of \$1,062,500 under Expenditure Head 10 (Community Development) for “Working Group on Promotion of Civic-Mindedness and Youth Affairs”, “Working Group on Community Involvement by Women”, “National Education Activities” and “Anti-corruption Activities”, and the proposed funding applications from

community organisations totalling \$680,077 recommended by Working Group;

- (vi) the reservation of a total of \$220,000 under Expenditure Head 11 (Community Organisations) for four Area Committees and the Mutual Aid Committees newly established after the first round of funding allocation, and the proposed funding applications from community organisations totalling \$655,550 recommended by Working Group; and
- (vii) the funding application in the amount of \$800,000 for “2011 Sha Tin Dragon Race” submitted by Sha Tin Sports Association. As the amount applied for exceeded \$250,000, the application had to be recommended to Finance and General Affairs Committee for consideration.

(2) Members noted:

- (i) the paper on “Virtual Trainer Scheme” submitted by Chinese University of Hong Kong;
- (ii) the replies of Intellectual Property Department, the LCSD, Composers and Authors Society of Hong Kong Limited, Hong Kong Recording Industry Alliance Limited and Phonographic Performance (South East Asia) Limited to the question on “Copyright Tariff on Music Performance”;
- (iii) the replies of the LCSD to the question on “Sports Ground Facilities”; and
- (iv) the minutes of meetings of the Committee’s Working Group on Promotion of Civic-Mindedness and Youth Affairs.
