Report on the meeting of  
Culture, Sports and Community Development Committee  
held on 28 April 2011

---

(1) The Committee endorsed:

- (i) the launching of the “Support Clean Elections” campaign in Sha Tin in collaboration with Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC), and elected Mr CHENG Cho-kwong, Ms LAM Chung-yan, Mr PUN Kwok-shan and Ms YEUNG Sin-hung to the Organising Committee for Anti-corruption Activities in Sha Tin;
- (ii) the formation of Working Group on Mid-autumn Festival (Ad Hoc), which would operate from 3 May to 30 September 2011 with Mr CHAN Yip-man as the convenor;
- (iii) two funding applications totalling \$199,970 submitted by Celebration Committee of Sha Tin Communities:
