

Sha Tin District Council

Report on the Enlarged Meeting of the Development and Housing Committee
held on 5 May 2011

- (1) The Committee discussed:
 - (i) Progress Report on 2011/2012 Sha Tin District Major Works Projects submitted by Civil Engineering and Development Department;
 - (ii) 2011 Work Plan for Sha Tin District Public Housing Management submitted by Housing Department; and
 - (iii) Briefing on 2011 Population Census submitted by Census and Statistics Department;.

- (2) The Committee endorsed:
 - (i) the following proposals of Working Group on District Improvement Works: implementation of a district improvement works project commissioned to term consultants, the total cost amounting to \$942,000; commissioning of the Works Section of Sha Tin District Office to implement a district minor works project with a reserved funding of \$1,200,000; revision of the funding applications for eight district minor works projects to cope with the need for extra cash flow incurred by trial pit projects, with the total amount being increased by \$450,000. The Committee also endorsed the financial arrangement for the district improvement works project that had already commenced;
 - (ii) the funding application of Working Group on Housing Affairs for the activities of this year, the approved amount being \$105,000; and
 - (iii) the funding application of Working Group on Economic Development and Labour Affairs for the activities of this year, the approved amount being \$255,000.

(3) The Committee noted:

- (i) the reply of Hong Kong Post Office to the question on the sales arrangement for Year of the Rabbit philatelic products;
- (ii) the replies of Mass Transit Railway Corporation Limited (MTRC), S E A Holdings Limited and Planning Department to the question on the redevelopment project at the site next to the MTR Fo Tan Station;
- (iii) the reply of Housing Department to the question on the lifts in Mei Lam Estate;
- (iv) the minutes of meetings of Working Group on Economic Development and Labour Affairs and Working Group on District Improvement Works, and the updated member list of Working Group on Economic Development and Labour Affairs;
- (v) the 2011/2012 Approved Estimates of the Expenditure Heads under the Committee;
- (vi) the population of public housing estates and Private Sector Participation Scheme courts in Sha Tin; and
- (vii) the financial status of Expenditure Head 2 (District Improvement Works) and the progress report on the proposed works.
