Report on the Meeting of District Facilities Management Committee  
held on 21 June 2011

---

- (1) The Committee endorsed:
- (i) the following proposals submitted by Working Group on District Facilities Works:
- (a) feasibility reports on ST-DMW150 “Construction of Public Toilets in the Park of Area 86” and ST-DMW168 “Sitting-out Area on Chik Choi Lane, Tai Wai ” submitted by the term consultant, the estimated costs being \$4,970,000 and \$2,398,000 respectively;
- (b) amendment of the funding application for ST-DMW11 “Provision of a Basketball Court in A Kung Kok Fishermen Village”, the amount being increased from \$3,480,000 to \$3,600,000; and
- (c) implementation of the four proposed new projects below and the funding arrangements:

(1) DMW148 Construction of a Sitting-out Area in Hung Mui Kuk	\$450,000
(2) Construction of a Leisure Park in Area 4C of Tai Wai	\$5,320,000
(3) Installation of Drinking Fountains in Sha Tin Park	\$180,000
(4) Installation of Drinking Fountains in Shing Mun River Promenade Garden No. 1 and Promenade Garden No. 2	\$180,000
<b>Total:</b>	<b>\$6,130,000</b>

- (ii) the two funding applications submitted by Working Group on the Management of Community Halls and Libraries:

(a) Extension of the opening hours of six Community Halls (from July 2011 to February 2012)	\$469,200
(b) Operating Expenses of the STDC Neighbourhood Activity Centre (from July 2011 to February 2012)	\$597,508
