

Sha Tin District Council

Report on the Meeting of Finance and General Affairs Committee
held on 12 July 2011

(1) The Committee endorsed:

- (i) the funding application in the amount of \$33,000 for the “Spring Reception co-organised by the Sha Tin District Council and Sha Tin District Office”, and gave special approval for holding the activity after 10 February 2012;
