

**Brief Summary of the 69<sup>th</sup> Meeting of the  
Yau Tsim Mong District Management Committee on 17 October 2006**

The Yau Tsim Mong District Management Committee held its 69<sup>th</sup> meeting on 17 October 2006. Members noted the contents of the Committee Papers presented at the meeting and the following are the salient points discussed.

**(I) Street Sleepers in Yau Tsim Mong**

2. From the report presented in the meeting, Members noted that while there was good progress in some of the cases, new cases were identified. Concerned departments would continue their efforts in tackling this problem.
3. Members also noted that LCSO had stepped up actions against street sleepers for staying in the Cultural Centre.

**(II) Social and Cultural Change**

4. A power point presentation was conducted by the Christian Action in respect of the service by “Integrated Service Centre for Ethnic Minority in Yau Tsim Mong”.
5. An EMB’s information note on “Education Support for Ethnic Minorities” was tabled in the meeting for Members’ information.
6. On the collaboration between government departments and the Christian Action on ethnic minorities issue in Yau Tsim Mong, it was suggested the Christian Action could assist to enhance the communication between government departments and the ethnic minorities who did not speak Chinese or English. In addition, the Christian Action could consider arranging Chinese language courses for the ethnic minorities children.

7. There was a suggestion from an unofficial member that closer co-operation could be made between the Christina Action and the YTMDC on programmes to integrate the ethnic minorities into the society.

**(III) Items which the government departments anticipate to consult the YTMDC or its Committees in the coming 3 months**

8. Members were informed of the agenda items for the coming YTMDC meeting to be held on 26 October 2006.

**(IV) Team Clean Initiatives and Progress Report on Clean Hong Kong District Action Plan for YTM District (August to September 2006)**

9. Members were briefed on the contents of the report. Members were told about the ovitrap indices of Mong Kong and Yau Tsim in September 2006. FEHD, YTMDO and other departments would work closely on the schedule of the joint tidying-up action to react to the changing environment.
