**Call for Departmental Attention to On-street Promotion by
Pirated Obscene Optical Disks Suppliers through
Card Distribution in Mong Kok**

Background

Activities related to pirated optical disks and obscene optical disks have disappeared for a while as departmental actions against them were stepped up. However, "flash mobs" appeared near Sino Centre in Nathan Road, Mong Kok in recent months. They distributed promotion cards for pirated optical disks, on which not only location maps for their purchase were printed, but also sexy photos of the female cast from the obscene optical disks.

These promotional activities are a nuisance to passers-by and a bad influence on young people. Tourists will be misled that Hong Kong is a pornographic city flooded with obscene optical disks, a disgrace to Hong Kong's international reputation. Worse still, these "flash mobs" might be connected with illicit triad activities.

Query and Request

1. Was there any complaint about the promotional activities described above in the last six months? How many complaints were received?
2. Has any measures or actions been taken against such activities? What is the outcome?
3. As the above act is an open challenge to the laws of Hong Kong, departmental actions should be stepped up to combat such activities.
