
## **Reply from the Lands Department:**

Inland Lot No. 7704 was granted to the University of Hong Kong in 1960. Pokfield Campus is presently situated at the Remaining Portion of Inland Lot No. 7704 (the Lot). The Lot is subject to a lease modification letter dated 28.7.2003. Under the said modification letter, the Lot is restricted to the purposes of provision of student hostels and ancillary facilities for students of the University of Hong Kong or other students as may be authorized by the University of Hong Kong (Pink Stippled Black Area on the attached plan), provision of domestic accommodation for the housing of the staff and employees of the University of Hong Kong and dependent members of the families of such staff and employees (Pink Hatched Brown Area on the attached plan) and the provision of recreational facilities for students of the University of Hong Kong or other students as may be authorized by the University of Hong Kong (Pink Area on the attached plan).

Knight Frank Petty Limited, on behalf of the University of Hong Kong, applied to the District Lands Office/Hong Kong West and South, Lands Department ("DLO") for the modification of the demarcation of the aforesaid area to tally with the relevant Outline Zoning Plan. The user of the Pink Area would be further relaxed to permit "Academic Use". In addition to the above, the University of Hong Kong also applied for the deletion of the height restriction of the Pink Stippled Black Area in accordance with the Buildings, Lands and Planning Department Joint Practice Note No. 5.

DLO is processing the land application under the established mechanism. The land application is being circulated to relevant Government Departments for comments with policy support given by the Education Bureau on nil premium and nil administrative fee. In addition, local consultation is being conducted.


