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OPERATIONAL PRIORITIES

Violent Crime

- Ensure a strong police presence supported by intelligence-led operations to deter violent crime.
- Professionally handle and investigate all reports of domestic violence.

Triads, Syndicated and Organised Crime

- Target triad personalities and activities, in particular those that exploit young persons and juveniles.

Dangerous Drugs

- Target drug traffickers, especially those exploiting young persons and juveniles.
- Deter the abuse of drugs on pleasure craft.
- Promote awareness and prevent the abuse of psychotropic drugs by students and juveniles through a multi-agency and community-based approach.

Quick Cash Crime

- Promote public awareness and secure community support to combat quick cash crime, particularly shop theft, pickpocketing, and street, telephone, Internet and social media deception.

Cyber Security and Technology Crime

- Promote public awareness of computer and cyber security, as well as the risks associated with social media through a multi-agency approach.
- Raise awareness and knowledge of frontline officers to professionally handle reports of technology crime.

Public Safety

- Ensure public order and safety of public events through effective planning and execution.
- Enhance the seafaring community's awareness of sea safety with a greater emphasis directed to recreational activities through education and enforcement.
- Promote safe cycling through community-based approach.
- Ensure preparedness for a quick and effective response to major incidents and disasters.
- Conduct regular multi-agency exercises to test and improve contingency plans.

Terrorism

- Promote target hardening and protection of critical infrastructure, International Ship and Port Facility Security (ISPS) and sensitive vessel movements.
- Enhance preparedness and response capability to the ISPS Code.
- Deploy marine resources to ensure a timely initial response, and an effective and coordinated approach.

Illegal Immigration

- Enhance intelligence gathering, cross-boundary liaison, use of technology and police presence to deter sea / bay crossers both inbound and outbound.
- Deter illegal immigrants involvement in illegal activities in Hong Kong waters.

Smuggling

- Target personalities and activities associated with syndicated smuggling.
- Strengthen the exchange of intelligence with other law enforcement agencies to target smuggling.
- Enhance cross-boundary liaison, use of technology, and a multi-agency approach to deter smuggling.

Multi-Agency Support to Maritime Environmental Protection

- Support joint operations, through a multi-agency approach, to deter Criminal / Illicit Activities with implications for conservation or the environment.

MANAGEMENT PRIORITIES

Engaging the Community

- Develop closer links with the seafaring and islands communities we serve to forge an effective police / public partnership.

Enhancing Personal and Professional Qualities of Force Members

- Promote a high standard of conduct and integrity to uphold Force core values and ethics.

Strengthening Criminal Intelligence Gathering Force-wide

- Strengthen criminal intelligence gathering by all officers of MPDIST.

Supporting Frontline Units

- Enhance frontline officers' knowledge through a structured training programme.
- Enhance frontline officers' capabilities by adopting appropriate technology.
- Encourage staff participation to identify measures to promote safety systems of work and enhance operational effectiveness.

Information Security

- Raise awareness of principles of information security.
- Identify risks and areas for improvement to prevent data leakage.
