Report of the CACRC Meeting held on 6 May 2013

Presentation of 2013/14 Workplan of Regional Office (Hong Kong West/Islands),
Independent Commission Against Corruption

Members unanimously agreed the provision of \$40,000 to the Independent Commission Against Corruption to conduct the “Keep Hong Kong Corruption Free Towards ICAC’s 40th Anniversary project for the Islands District” in 2013/14.

Establishment of “Tung Chung Youth Outreaching Team” of The Neighbourhood
Advice – Action Council (NAAC)

2. Members unanimously agreed on the site selection of the office of the “Tung Chung Youth Outreaching Team”. They also gave advice on the service areas and time and manpower of the Team.

Reports by Working Groups

(i) Vetting Group

3. Members noted that at the meeting held on 10 April, 2013, the Vetting Group processed 46 applications for Community Involvement Fund for activities to be held between June and August, 2013. The Vetting Group also decided that funding application(s) of an organization would be suspended, until the organization would return the advance of fund for an activity the sponsorship of which had been withdrawn due to violation of regulations.

(ii) CACRC Working Group

4. Members noted the progress of two civic education activities.

Reports on the work of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department in Islands District

5. Members noted the progress of the recreational and cultural activities, as well as the promotion of public library activities conducted by the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) in the Islands District.

Any Other Business

(i) Public Education Activities on Rehabilitation in 2013/14

6. Members agreed that the above-mentioned activity would be organized by the International Rehabilitation Day Working Group.

(ii) Funding Scheme for Women's Development in 2013/14

7. Members agreed that the CACRC Working Group would discuss how to make use of the fund allocated to it to implement the Scheme.

(iii) Arts and Cultural Activities at the District Level

8. Members agreed that the matter would be followed up by the CACRC Working Group.

(iv) The Funding Allocation of Leisure and Cultural Services Department

9. The LCSD would conduct a trial-run of the advance booking system of the Pui O Campsite. Thus part of the fund provided by the District Council would be used to hire staff to handle the booking procedures. Members noted and agreed with the arrangement.
