Report of the CACRC Meeting held on 5 May 2014

Question on Organizing Chinese Dances Training Class at Discovery Bay Community Hall

The Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) said that as instructors could not be arranged, thus the proposed training class could not be implemented yet. The Department would follow up on the matter. Members hoped that the Department would be able to engage instructors as soon as possible so as to materialize the proposal.

Work Plan 2014/2015 Regional Office (Hong Kong West/Islands) Independent Commission Against Corruption

2. Members approved the funding of \$20,000 for organizing anti-corruption activities in Islands District in 2014/2015, and gave their advice on the location of Regional Office (Hong Kong West/Islands) Independent Commission Against Corruption.

Setting up of “The Wellness Centre (Islands)- Yat Tung Estate (Sub-base) of New Life Psychiatric Rehabilitation Association Integrated Community Centre for Mental Wellness

3. Members supported the establishment of the above sub-base, and gave their advice and raised enquiries on the services of the Association.

Reports of Working Groups

(i) Vetting Group

4. At the meeting held on 14 April 2014, the Vetting Group processed 47 applications for Community Involvement Fund for activities to be held between June and August 2014, including those of “Peng Chau Day” and “Mui Wo Day”. Relevant funding proposals had been submitted to the

Committee for consideration and endorsement through circulation paper(s). Members also noted the contents of 5 activities evaluation reports and there were no negative comments in these reports.

(ii) CACRC Working Group

5. Members noted the progress of CPCE's Cooperation Scheme with District Council 2014-15.

6. Members noted the progress of the recreational and cultural activities, as well as that of the promotion of public library activities conducted by the LCSD in the Islands District.

7. The Committee agreed that Arts and Cultural activities at district level would continue to be organized in 2014/2015 and related matters would be followed up on by the CACRC Working Group.

8. Members agreed that public education activities on rehabilitation in 2014/2015 would be organized by International Day of Disabled Persons Working Group in Islands District and Mr TANG Ka-piu, Bill, would continue to be its convener.
