Report of the CACRC Meeting held on 7 July 2014

Question on Organizing Chinese Dances Training Class at Discovery Bay Community Hall

The Leisure and Cultural Services Department (LCSD) had arranged a newly registered instructor to teach Chinese Dances in Discovery Bay, and the Discovery Bay Community Hall would be reserved as venue for instruction. If the venue reservation was successful, Chinese Dances classes in Discovery Bay could begin in September 2014 on a trial basis.

Reports of Working Groups

(i) Vetting Group

2. At a meeting held earlier, the Vetting Group processed funding application for “2014 Exhibition on heritage of Tai O Waterside Village - Wedding Ceremony on Water” and 59 applications for Community Involvement Fund for activities to be held between September and October 2014, and proposals for the current year’s occupational safety and health promotional activities. Relevant funding proposals had been approved by the Committee through circulation paper.

(ii) CACRC Working Group

3. Members noted the progress of CPCE’s Cooperation Scheme with District Council 2014-15, Islands District Cantonese Opera Show 2014 and Islands District Women Development Scheme 2014.

(iii) International Day of Disabled Persons Working Group

4. Members noted the arrangements of various activities held under “International Day of Disabled Persons”.

Reports on the work of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department in Islands District

5. Members noted the progress of the recreational and cultural activities, as well as that of the promotion of public library activities conducted by the LCSD in Islands District. Members also gave views and raised enquiries on using Mui Wo Town Square and Tung Chung Swimming Pool for organizing activities.

Other Business

6. Members endorsed the composition of the delegation of Islands District in “The 5th Hong Kong Games” and the selection mechanism of athletes. Members also endorsed the funding of \$64,000 for subsidizing the transportation, meals, uniforms and T-shirts expenses for the representatives. Members gave their views on subsidizing the transportation of participants.

7. Members agreed to assist in publicizing and promoting “Sports for All Day 2014” in the District.
