**Report of the TAFEHC Meeting held on 28 July 2014**

Review of the Hotel and Guesthouse Accommodation Ordinance (Cap.349)

Members gave their views on areas to be regulated in the Ordinance, licensing system of hotels and guesthouses, and enforcement against unlicensed hotels and guesthouses.

Development of a Community Green Station

2. Many members expressed their support of the above programme, and gave their views on site selection, contents and the Government's work in waste reduction and recycling.

5. The Islands District Office had instructed the contractors to be mindful of the progress of works and follow-up work to be conducted.

## Progress report on DC-funded District Minor Works Projects

6. Members endorsed the contents of the paper and enquired about the progress of various work projects. The Committee approved the most updated funding for “Construction of Footbridge near No.27 Chung Mei, Sok Kwu Wan, South Lamma (IS-DMW-581)” and “Improvement to open space in front of house no. 489 to 494 at Nam Wan San Tsuen, Peng Chau (IS-DMW-630)” were both \$300,000. The Committee also approved that the six project proposals listed below would be included into the District Minor Works Projects of the Committee:

- Improvement to footpath near house no. 1 at Lung Mei Tsuen, Mui Wo;
- Construction of rainshelter at Nam Bin Wai, Mui Wo;
- Improvement to footpath and surface channel leading from house no. 15 to house no. 19 at Sha Lo Wan, Tai O;
- Improvement to drainage channel near playground at Sha Lo Wan Tsuen, Tai O;
- Desilting works to channel at Sha Lo Wan, Tai O; and
- Provision of rainshelter near lamp post no. FC 2098 at Man Tung Road, Tung Chung.

7. Members gave their views on the contents of the report. Members also endorsed the proposals and contents as contained in the report of the TAFEHC Working Group and that of Islands Healthy City Working Group.
