Traffic and Transport Committee (TTC)

Report of the TTC Meeting held on 19 January 2015

Construction of Additional Sewage Rising Main and Rehabilitation of Existing Sewage Rising Main between Tung Chung and Siu Ho Wan

Members noted the contents of the paper, and requested the Drainage Services Department (DSD) to take effective measures to reduce the impact on traffic during construction period. Members opined that the project should include pipework linking Tai Ho, Ngau Kwu Long, Pak Mong and the main pipe, so as to resolve the three villages' sewage treatment issue. The DSD was requested to follow up on the matter.

Question on split of Long Win bus route S64

2. Long Win Bus Company would make changes to the frequencies of S64X and S64C during the morning peak hours in order to resolve the issue of passengers having difficulty in boarding buses after the splitting of the bus route. Members gave many proposals on the issue.

Question on truck parking space in Tung Chung

3. The Transport Department said that it would follow up on the issue of inadequate parking spaces for trucks in Tung Chung area. Members gave many proposals on using Yu Tung Road outside Yat Tung Estate at night for parking spaces for coaches after the temporary bus terminus was formally opened for use. Members also requested the Transport Department to look into the issue of inadequate parking spaces for private vehicles.

Question on Improvement works at Mui Wo (Phase 2, Stage 1)

4. The Civil Engineering and Development Department said that the current proposal was to move the perimeter wall of the New Territories Heung Yee Kuk Southern District Secondary School (the school) slightly inwards, so as to make use of the space which housed the septic tank for re-routing of the road. Members gave many proposals on the improvement works, including that the works should not intrude on the school area.

Members also requested the Education Bureau to conduct consultation when considering any use of the school premises.

Question on oil price stabilization fund

5. Members agreed that the proposal of oil price stabilization fund would be followed up by the existing working group under the TTC.

Question on MTR interchange discounts kiosk

6. Members requested the setting up of MTR interchange discounts kiosks in various piers of Islands District.

Question on vehicle parking problem at Tung Chung Waterfront Road

7. The Transport Department said that it would follow up on the vehicle parking problem in the vicinity of Waterfront Road and Mei Tung Road in Tung Chung.

Reports by TTC Activity Working Group

8. The Committee noted that the Working Group was conducting tender for production of publicity materials.

Any Other Business

9. Members noted the minor traffic improvements works to be conducted by the Highways Department in Islands District before mid-January 2015 and their schedule. Members enquired the progress of various works and the Department was asked to implement the works as soon as possible.
