We will continue to develop and enhance good community relations and foster a partnership approach with community-based organizations and other government departments. We will ensure a high degree of effort is given towards enhancing public safety on both land and sea.

OPERATIONAL PRIORITIES

Violent Crime

- Maintain a robust response capability to maritime threats.
- Deter violent crime by delivering a strong police presence in population centres on outlying islands.
- Professionally handle and investigate all reports of violent crime.

Triads, Syndicated and Organised Crime

- Target triad personalities and activities, in particular those that exploit young persons and juveniles.
- Leverage the cross-boundary mechanism, make full use of available resources and technology and adopt a multi-agency approach to deter and interdict organized criminal activities.

Dangerous Drugs

- Take robust action against drug traffickers, especially those exploiting young persons and juveniles.
- Deter the abuse of illicit drugs on pleasure craft.
- Promote awareness and prevent the abuse of psychotropic drugs by students and juveniles through a multi-agency and community-based approach.

Quick Cash Crime

• Promote public awareness and secure community support to combat quick cash crime on land and miscellaneous thefts at sea.

Cyber Security and Technology Crime

- Promote public awareness of computer crime and cyber security, as well as the risks associated with social media.
- Work with key partners to promote maritime industry awareness of computer crime and cyber security.

Public Safety

- Ensure public order and safety of public events through effective planning and execution.
- Enhance sea safety awareness and regulatory compliance within the seafaring communities.
- Take measures to enhance safe cycling and pedestrian safety on the outlying islands.
- Strengthen preparedness for a quick and effective response to major incidents and natural disasters.

Terrorism

- Ensure a proactive patrolling profile at ISPS facilities and visiting vessels as well as critical infrastructure and other key points to enhance deterrence and protection.
- Ensure preparedness and response capability to the ISPS Code through regular review of contingency plans and frequent exercises and drills.
- Strengthen anti-terrorism focus with stakeholders under the ISPS Code.

Illegal Immigration & Smuggling

- Deter and interdict illegal immigration and smuggling.
- Combat illegal activities by illegal immigrants and visitors on the outlying islands.

Supporting Martime Environmental Protection

• Conduct joint operations, through a multi-agency approach, to combat criminal/illicit activities with implications for conservation or the environment.

MANAGEMENT PRIORITIES

Engaging the Community

- Develop and enhance our relationship with the seafaring and islands communities to forge a more effective police/public partnership.
- Continue and develop specific initiatives for Junior Police Call, Senior Police Call, Recreational Sea Safety and Non-ethnic Chinese.

Enhancing Personal and Professional Qualities of Force Members

- Promote a high standard of conduct and integrity in support of Force core values and ethics.
- Promote training and culture building to improve the standards of policing, seamanship and safety.

Strengthening Criminal Intelligence Gathering

 Promote a culture of information gathering by all officers of MPDIST in support of the Force Criminal Intelligence System (FCIS).

Supporting Frontline Units

- Promote staff empowerment and ownership to enhance operational effectiveness, promote safe systems of work and raise morale.
- Enhance frontline officers' capabilities by adopting appropriate technology.

Information Security

- Maintain officers' vigilance towards the risks of data leakage and enhance their awareness of information security principles.
- Implement and manage the IT Warden system within Divisions to enhance information security.

Manpower and Succession Planning

• Address succession planning through mentoring, on-the-job training and knowledge management to appropriately equip younger officers with marine policing skill sets.

Resource Management

 To establish a culture of prudent resource management in respect of fuel, electricity and other resources, balanced with operational need
