LOCAL OPERATIONAL PRIORITIES

Maintain a strong visible police presence and engage all sectors of community to gain their support in local policing

Burglary

- Developing a communication platform and enhancing intelligence-sharing with the local communities
- Enhancing burglary prevention awareness of residential security personnel and local residents
- Ensuring a rapid and robust response capability

Tourist-related Crimes

- Maintaining close liaison with various management company of tourist spots for effective crime prevention
- Ensuring timely operations to combat all tourist-related crimes

- Deploying police resources effectively to other areas of concern as highlighted in the Commissioner's Operational Priorities and the Regional Action Plan
