Question on a traffic accident occurred outside Discovery Bay
International School

Ms Amy YUNG notified this Council that she would raise the following question at the Islands District Council meeting to be held on 24 April this year:

“ In the afternoon of 17 March this year, a traffic accident occurred outside Discovery Bay International School (DBIS). The residents reported that a girl wearing the DBIS uniform was hit by a private car and sent to hospital with injuries. I am concerned about the safety of residents. As such, I would like to invite representatives of the Hong Kong Police Force (HKPF), Discovery Bay Services Management Limited (DBSML) and the Transport Department (TD) to attend the meeting to respond to the following questions:

1. The cause of the traffic accident and the prevailing road conditions.
2. Was the private car an outside vehicle, and whether it had entered Discovery Bay illegally?
3. Who was the owner if the private car was not an outside vehicle?
4. Would DBSML provide safety facilities such as zebra crossing or cautionary crossing in the school areas?
5. What advice would TD and HKPF offer in relation to the traffic safety in the school areas of Discovery Bay? ”
