**Question on light pollution caused by Hong Kong Disneyland Resort**

Ms Amy YUNG notified this Council that she would raise the following enquiry at the Islands District Council meeting to be held on 18 December this year:

“ The spotlights at the waterfront promenade near Hong Kong Disneyland Resort switched on every night, and intense white light lights up the entire hotel and the adjacent area. As the Discovery Bay residences lie exactly opposite the hotel, residents complained that the glare causes discomfort to them, impairing their sleep quality and affecting their daily lives. Research studies show that prolonged exposure to intense light is harmful to one’s vision.

As such, I would like Hong Kong Disneyland to respond to the following questions:

1. Can it require the hotel to adjust the brightness level of the lights for different period of time?
2. Can it request the hotel to address the light pollution so as to reduce the light nuisance to the residents? ”
