Question on light pollution caused by Hong Kong Disneyland Resort
(Paper IDC 140/2017)

Written reply from Hong Kong Disneyland Resort

Hong Kong Disneyland Resort thanks Ms Amy Yung, Islands District Council Member, for raising her enquiry about the lighting along the Waterfront Promenade of Hong Kong Disneyland Resort. The matter has been carefully looked into, and it is understood the light comes from lighting bollards installed along the promenade outside our newest hotel, Disney Explorers Lodge, which opened in April, 2017. The purpose of these new pathway lights is to provide safe and appropriate lighting to our hotel guests and other users of the promenade. These bollards are about 1 meter above ground level and the lamps are switched on daily between sunset and sunrise. We care deeply about the relationship between the resort and the nearby community, including Discovery Bay, which is around 2 kilometers away from us. The resort will review the relevant lighting systems based on operational needs from time to time. While our aim is to provide safe lighting conditions, we will also take into consideration the impact on the community.
