LOCAL OPERATIONAL PRIORITIES

Maintain a strong visible police presence and engage all sectors of community to gain their support in local policing

Burglary

- Developing a communication platform and enhancing intelligence-sharing with the local community.
- Enhancing burglary prevention awareness of residential security personnel and local residents.
- Ensuring a rapid and robust operational capability against burglary.

Tourist-related Crimes

- Maintaining a close liaison with various management companies of tourist spots for effective crime prevention.
- Combating tourist-related crimes by strategic deployment of manpower.

Engaging the Non-Ethnic Chinese (NEC)

- Strengthening the engagement with the growing NEC community.

Commissioning of HZMB HKBCF

- Ensuring District's readiness for the commissioning of HZMB in a safe and orderly manner.

Other Priorities

- Handling and investigating all reports of domestic violence professionally.
- Enhancing traffic enforcement in closed roads and maintaining close liaison with respective stakeholders in view of the increasing number of closed road users.
- Enhancing crime prevention for deception related crimes.
- Supporting the institutionalization of criminal intelligence gathering through recognition, active participation of supervisory officers.
- Deploying police resources effectively to areas of concern as highlighted in the Commissioner's Operational Priorities and the Regional Action Plan.

Project 'LantauEyes'

- Cooperating with District Fight Crime Committee, Rural Committees, village representatives and other stakeholders to promote and facilitate villagers to install communal security camera system for prevention and detection of crime.
