Question on MTR Tung Chung Line

Ms. Amy YUNG notified this Council that she would raise the following enquiry at the Islands District Council meeting to be held on 1 February this year:

“ Many passengers opined that the train service of MTR Tung Chung Line cannot meet their demand. I am afraid the situation will worsen upon the completion of the 8-carriage train conversion project of West Rail Line and if Tung Chung New Town Extension Project and projects at New Development Areas at Hung Shui Kiu and Kam Tin are to be implemented ultimately.

As such, I request the MTRCL to arrange representatives to attend the meeting and explain the following:

1. whether the Corporation will study the feasibility of extending the platform length of the existing stations of Tung Chung Line and the future Tung Chung West and Tung Chung East Stations so that the carrying capacity will be enhanced with the provision of longer trains on Tung Chung Line?
2. whether the frequency of trains running on Tung Chung Line can be further increased and all trains terminated at Tung Chung Station in the near future? ”
