**Question on provision of automated external defibrillators in
Community Halls in Islands District**

Ms Amy YUNG notified this Council that she would raise the following enquiry at the District Facilities Management Committee meeting to be held on 13 July 2020:

“ Community halls (CHs) are where public and social gatherings and elections take place. With an ageing population and the trend of heart diseases among younger people, I suggest that at least one automated external defibrillator (AED) should be installed in each CH in different districts.

As such, I would like the representative of the Islands District Office (IsDO) to respond to the following:

1. Have AEDs been installed in the two CHs in Islands District? If no, where is the nearest AED in the area?
2. Would IsDO install AEDs in the existing and future CHs and provide courses regularly at CHs to ensure that the duty staff and the public how to use the AEDs properly? ”
