**Question on restricting discussion by District Council to livelihood issues only**

Ms Amy YUNG notified this Council that she would raise the following enquiry at the Islands District Council (IDC) meeting to be held on 19 October this year:

“ It is learnt that internal guidelines have been issued by the Chief Secretary for Administration to restrict discussion at District Council (DC) meetings to livelihood-related issues only, and discussion on territory-wide politicised social events is prohibited, otherwise District Officers and government representatives may be absent from the meetings and there will be no need to provide secretariat service to DCs. I would like the representatives of the Home Affairs Department to respond to the following:

Given that the \$1,000 billion Lantau Tomorrow Vision plan is within the ambit of IDC and also a territory-wide politicised social event, can IDC discuss it in the future? ”
