Operational Priorities

National Security

- ❖ Enhance frontline officers' skill and knowledge of their roles and responsibilities, and intelligence gathering capability in safeguarding national security.
- Enhance communication and cooperation with all national security safeguarding government bodies and other relevant stakeholders, and enlist public trust and support for the roles and responsibilities of Police in safeguarding national security.

Violent Crime

- Ensure an effective, strong, and highly visible police presence at key locations to deter violent crime, particularly at high-risk locations.
- Strengthen intelligence-led operations against street gangs and their activities, particularly those involving youths.
- Ensure professional and sensitive case handling when investigating violent crime, particularly those cases involving vulnerable persons.

Triads, Syndicated and Organised Crime

❖ Take proactive enforcement action against debt-collection agencies who threaten life and property, in particular those who seek to exploit youths.

Drugs and Substance Abuse by Students and Youths

Adopt a multi-agency and community-based approach to prevent drugs and substance abuse by students and youths.

Quick Cash Crime

- Promote crime prevention and raise awareness to prevent quick cash crime, particularly pickpocket and all forms of deception and fraud.
- Strengthen community support to interdict shop and miscellaneous theft.

Cyber Security and Technology Crime

- ❖ Enhance public awareness of cyber security as well as the risks and liabilities associated with the Internet and social media through a multi-agency approach.
- ❖ Take proactive measures to investigate and gather intelligence for tackling technology crime and cyber attack.

Operational Priorities

Burglary / Smuggling

❖ Effectively task and deploy police resources to deter burglary and smuggling, and reassure local communities.

Street Management

❖ Implement consistent and determined enforcement action to deter Street Gambling, Illegal Parking and other anti-social behaviours.

Public Safety

- (a) Hong Kong Zhuhai Macao Bridge (HZMB) Hong Kong Boundary Crossing Facilities (HKBCF) and Public Transport Operators
- Secure effective communication and liaison with the operators and key strategic partners to protect the integrity and security of HZMB HKBCF and public transport infrastructure.

(b) Public Disorder

- Strengthen public awareness of importance of being law abiding citizens through co-operation with different stakeholders, including government bureaux/departments, schools and non-governmental organisations (NGOs).
- Enhance preparedness, readiness and capability in dealing with all scales of public disorder.
- Enhance cooperation with other stakeholders including government bureaux/departments, private entities, schools and NGOs, and enlist their support in maintaining and restoring public order and safety during and after any incidents of public disorder.

(c) Public Events

- Strengthen public trust, understanding of, and support for, the roles and responsibilities of Police in maintaining public order and safety for the community.
- ❖ Ensure public events, sports, entertainment and celebratory events are held in a safe and orderly manner through proactive engagement with relevant stakeholders, including event organisers and venue operators, for effective planning and execution.

(d) Road Safety

- ❖ Implement a multi-agency approach to promote road safety and reduce fatal and serious traffic accidents.
- Ensure smooth traffic flow through the application of the Selected Traffic Enforcement Priorities (STEP) and the use of technology.

(e) Major Incidents and Disasters

- Ensure the preparedness for the rescue phase of major incidents by conducting regular multi-agency exercises to test and improve contingency plans.
- Provide a professional, coordinated and rapid response, with engagement of stakeholders communitywide.

Cooperate with and render support to other government bureaux/departments in the implementation of anti-epidemic measures, and strengthen relevant enforcement actions.

Operational Priorities

Terrorism

- Build capacity and enhance operational readiness through regular training and multi-agency exercises.
- Enhance public participation and preparedness against terrorist or violent attacks by collaboration with the operators of critical infrastructure and other key locations including HZMB, HK Disneyland, MTRC, and Ngong Ping 360 to enhance protection, reduce vulnerability and strengthen multi-agency response capability.

❖ Disseminate crime prevention messages through various digital platforms.

Vision Possible

Provide a platform for young people to engage in healthy activities and to develop leadership and life skills.

One World

Expand engagement activities with the objective of promoting a tolerant, inclusive, and harmonious community for all.

Lantau Eyes

Work in partnership with District Fight Crime Committee, Rural Committees, Village Representatives and other key stakeholders to develop a sense of shared ownership in tackling policing issues.

SHIELDGUARD

Combat against illegal debt-collection activities.

LTDIST Upgrade

Closely monitor the HKSARG's future development plans for Lantau and ensure policing infrastructure and manning scales meet both Force and community needs.
