

**Hong Kong Resort Company Limited's Proposal for
Rescinding Prohibited Zones for Taxis in Discovery Bay and
Adding Taxi Stands in Discovery Bay South**

This paper aims to consult members' view on the Hong Kong Resort Company Limited ("HKR")'s proposal for rescinding the existing prohibited zones for taxis in Discovery Bay and adding four taxi stands in Discovery Bay South.

2. Since October 2014, Urban and Lantau taxis can enter the Yi Pak area in Discovery Bay North. This Department has received HKR's proposal earlier for requesting to rescind the existing prohibited zones for taxis in Discovery Bay and adding four taxi stands in Discovery Bay South so as to facilitate residents' commuting by taxi. HKR's detailed proposal (including relevant traffic control measures) is at Annex.
3. The land ownership of Discovery Bay is privately held, and all roads within the area are private roads. The Discovery Bay Services Management Limited is responsible for daily traffic management and road maintenance. Also, HKR conducted local consultation in February and March this year. Based on the result of the consultation and comments from other relevant government departments, HKR will further follow up. HKR will release and explain the consultation results to its residents at a later stage, and respond to residents' views.
4. Members are invited to offer comment on HKR's proposal above.
