Opening Remarks

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the Community Involvement, Culture and Recreation Committee (“CICRC”) and government representatives to the 12th meeting of CICRC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

2. The Chairman extended a special welcome to Ms Kinki FONG, Deputy District Leisure Manager (District Support) Kwun Tong of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (“LCSD”), for attending this meeting for the first time.

3. The Chairman said that the Secretariat had not received any notice of absence from Members before the meeting.

I. Confirmation of Minutes of the 11th Meeting of CICRC

4. The Secretariat had earlier circulated the draft minutes of the last meeting to all Members. Members had not raised any other comments prior to and during the meeting. The minutes of the 11th meeting were confirmed.

II. Half-yearly Report on Community Involvement Programme of Kwun Tong District Office for 2025/26 (April to September 2025) **(KTDC CICRC Paper No. 23/2025)**

III. Half-yearly Report on Arts and Cultural Activities Organised by LCSD in Kwun Tong District (April to September 2025)

7. The representative of LCSD presented the paper.
8. Members raised views and enquiries as follows:
 - 8.1 Members suggested that LCSD organise more community cultural activities at the East Kowloon Cultural Centre (“EKCC”) to enhance community cohesion.
 - 8.2 Members suggested that LCSD organise cultural activities in communities such as Sau Mau Ping and Lam Tin to facilitate participation by residents from different areas of the district.
 - 8.3 Members considered that LCSD could use accessories created during previous workshops as promotional materials to attract public participation in its activities.
9. The Chairman suggested that LCSD collaborate with Care Teams to promote Chinese culture in the community.
10. The representative of LCSD responded to Members’ views and enquiries as follows:
 - 10.1 The department stated that it would consider organising cultural activities at EKCC to enhance community cohesion.
 - 10.2 The department stated that it would relay Members’ views regarding activity venues to the relevant personnel.
 - 10.3 The department stated that it would explore collaboration with Care Teams to promote Chinese culture.
 - 10.4 Regarding the use of accessories made in workshops for promotional purposes, the department stated that it would relay the views to the relevant personnel.

 - 19.1 Members suggested that LCSD incorporate elements of intangible cultural heritage into cultural and arts activities.
 - 19.2 Members suggested that LCSD strengthen collaboration with district organisations and Care Teams to organise more cultural and leisure activities.
20. The representative of LCSD responded to Members' views and enquiries as follows:
 - 20.1 The department stated that it would relay Members' suggestions regarding the content

of activities to the relevant personnel.

20.2 The department stated that the activities organised by LCSD in 2025-26 had received considerable support from district organisations, and that it would continue to collaborate with these organisations in the coming year.

21. Members raised follow-up views and enquiries as follows:

21.1 Members enquired whether LCSD would invite district organisations, by means of invitation letters, to become supporting organisations of its activities.

21.2 Members commended Senior Manager (Kowloon East) of LCSD for her proactive efforts in coordinating collaboration between district organisations and LCSD, and expressed the hope that LCSD would continue to maintain close communication and collaboration with district organisations to enhance the effectiveness of activities.

21.3 Members suggested that the Secretariat consolidate information on district organisations for LCSD's reference.

22. The representative of LCSD stated that, in the coming year, the department would issue letters to district organisations based on the latest list provided by the Secretariat, inviting them to become supporting organisations of its activities.

To promote the importance of regular participation in sports and other physical activities to the public, LCSD hoped to obtain the support of KTDC to nominate no fewer than two KTDC Members to serve as the new-term Sports Ambassadors for Kwun Tong District, for a two-year term from January 2026 to December 2027.

31. The Chairman reported that the Secretariat had sought the views of Members before the meeting and had received expressions of interest in serving as Sports Ambassadors from Ms FU Pik-chun, Mr WONG Kai-san, Mr YU Siu-lun, Mr TSANG Wing-fai and Ms ZHAN Baoyu.

32. As no other Members expressed interest in serving as Sports Ambassadors during the meeting, the Chairman announced the nomination of the above five Members to serve as Sports Ambassadors for Kwun Tong District for the new term.
