**Opening Remarks**

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the Community Involvement, Culture and Recreation Committee (“CICRC”) and government representatives to the 5th meeting of CICRC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

2. The Chairman extended a special welcome to the Co-opt Members, Mr LIN Tin-yi and Mr LEUNG Ki-sum, for attending this meeting for the first time.

3. The Chairman said that the Secretariat had received a notice of absence from Mr MA Yat-chiu before the meeting. CICRC consented to Mr MA’s application for absence due to its compliance with Order 64 (1) of the Kwun Tong District Council Standing Orders.

**I. Confirmation of Minutes of the 4th Meeting of CICRC**

4. The Secretariat had earlier circulated the draft minutes of the last meeting to all Members. Members had not raised any other comments prior to and during the meeting. The minutes of the 4th meeting were confirmed.

**II. Report on Arts and Cultural Activities Organised by Leisure and Cultural Services Department (“LCSD”) in Kwun Tong District (KTDC CICRC Paper No. 22/2024)**

5. The representative of LCSD presented the paper.

6. Members enquired about the duration of “Theatre Space ‘The High-spirited Hong Kong Detective Musical’” and whether seating would be provided.

7. The representative of LCSD said that the musical would last approximately one hour and include music and drama elements. The arts group estimated an attendance of about 100 people, and seating would be provided.

8. Members enquired about the reason for the discrepancy between the actual and estimated number of participants for ‘Music in Martial Arts Community’ - Music Theatre: The Music Secret of Wong Fei-hung.

9. The representative of LCSD explained that the actual number of participants was unsatisfactory due to inclement weather on the event day. In addition, most of the participants were elderly people, and the event was not a parent-child activity.

10. Members noted the paper.

**III. Report on Recreation and Sports Programmes Organised by LCSD in Kwun Tong District**  
**(KTDC CICRC Paper No. 23/2024)**

11. The representative of LCSD presented the paper and stated that the department would organise the “Enjoy the Fun” Carnival @ National Day at Kwun Tong Promenade on 1 October. An invitation letter would be sent to District Council Members later via the Secretariat. The parent-child-themed event would feature various types of booths, games and performances. Members were welcome to attend.

12. Members noted the paper.

**IV. Report on Promotional Activities Organised by Public Libraries of LCSD in Kwun Tong District**  
**(KTDC CICRC Paper No. 24/2024)**

13. The representative of LCSD presented the paper and thanked Members for participating in the visit to the Self-service Library Station (“SSLS”) at the Hong Kong Cultural Centre in Tsim Sha Tsui on 9 August 2024.

14. Members raised views and enquiries as follows:
  - 14.1 Members enquired about the cost of SSLs and mobile library vans. They hoped that LCSD would provide such facilities in Kwun Tong District or new communities to encourage the public to read.
  - 14.2 Members commended LCSD for taking on board their suggestion to incorporate content related to national education, historical development and arts and culture in promotional activities.
  - 14.3 Members suggested that LCSD organise activities with different themes in the community, such as national education or “Deconstructing Tiangong Space Station”, to facilitate Members’ promotion of reading culture in the community and interaction with residents.
  - 14.4 Members suggested that LCSD consider adopting a diversified approach to promote reading culture, such as setting up check-in spots and launching a reading scheme that allowed members of the public to redeem souvenirs with points.
  - 14.5 Members suggested that LCSD provide electronic promotional posters to facilitate the display of event information on the display panels at Members’ ward offices, thereby enhancing publicity effectiveness.
15. The representative of LCSD responded to Members’ views and enquiries as follows:
  - 15.1 LCSD indicated that SSLs were part of the Smart Library System, which encompassed hardware and software for SSLs, static libraries and mobile libraries. Hence, it was difficult to assess the cost of SSLs alone. LCSD would continue to extend the service after completing the update of the entire new system to enable more members of the public to use SSLs.
  - 15.2 LCSD thanked Members for their commendation of the promotional activities and advised that the six libraries in Kwun Tong District would hold Book Displays on Chinese culture in October. Chinese culture would also be adopted as the theme of Storytelling for Children sessions to strengthen children’s sense of national identity and foster their sense of belonging to the country.
  - 15.3 LCSD indicated that various activities were held at community libraries from time to

time, and they had been well received by residents. LCSD said it would continue to organise activities in the community in the coming year.

15.4 Regarding electronic promotional posters, LCSD said that it would continue to disseminate them to Members via email in the future. If Members had other publicity material needs, LCSD would be pleased to accommodate them.

15.5 Regarding promoting reading, LCSD pointed out that some libraries in the district had been giving out souvenirs to members of the public based on the amount of library materials borrowed.

16. The Chairman agreed that content related to Chinese culture, history, technological development, etc. should be incorporated into promotional activities. He also suggested that LCSD upload selected activity clips for public download, which would also facilitate Members' promotion of activities to the public.

17. The representative of LCSD advised that the department had established the "Edutainment Channel", which featured videos on Chinese culture. In addition, LCSD indicated that, subject to consent from speakers or activity groups, audio or video recordings of activities would be uploaded onto the Multimedia Information System of the Hong Kong Public Libraries for public viewing. LCSD said that information about the websites concerned would be disseminated to Members through the Secretariat in due course.

18. Members noted the paper.

**V. Any Other Business**

19. Members did not raise other items for discussion.

**VI. Date of Next Meeting**

20. The next meeting was scheduled to be held at 2:30 p.m. on 14 November 2024 (Thursday).

21. There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:56 p.m.
