Opening Remarks

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the Food, Environment and Hygiene Committee (“FEHC”) and government representatives to the 11th meeting of FEHC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

I. Confirmation of Minutes of Last Meeting

2. Members had no further comments and the minutes of the 10th meeting were confirmed.

II. Progress report on environmental hygiene issues by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department **(KTDC FEHC Paper No. 18/2025)**

3. The representative of the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (“FEHD”) presented the paper.

4. The Chairman commended FEHD for reporting the locations of gravidtraps with positive indices at the Kwun Tong West Area Committee meeting, and suggested that the department also report the same information at other Area Committee meetings.

5. Members praised FEHD for its proactive follow-up on environmental hygiene issues around Kai Tin Tower.

6. Members noted the matter.

**III. Environmental Hygiene Problems in Kwun Tong District
(KTDC FEHC Paper No. 19/2025)**

7. The Secretary presented the paper.

8. The Chairman requested FEHD to follow up on the illegal refuse deposit issue near the flower beds on Kai Tin Road and to step up inspections and enforcement action at the location.

9. Members raised views and enquiries as follows:

9.1 Members commended FEHD for its proactive follow-up on environmental hygiene issues in the district.

9.2 Members urged FEHD to follow up on the accumulation of miscellaneous articles in the back alleys of Ting On Street, Ngau Tau Kok, as well as mosquito infestation and environmental hygiene issues at the open-air car park on Wang Kwong Road.

9.3 Members noted mosquito infestation at the construction site of Hiu Yan Estate on Hiu Ming Street and the slopes near Tsui Ping (North) Estate, and hoped that FEHD would proactively follow up and assist the estates in stepping up mosquito control work.

10. The representative of FEHD responded to Members' views and enquiries as follows:

10.1 FEHD stated that staff would be deployed to investigate illegal refuse deposit at the flower beds on Kai Tin Road, and that inspections and enforcement action would be stepped up. FEHD would take prosecution action against the persons involved if there was sufficient evidence.

10.2 FEHD would continue to closely monitor the hygiene conditions of the open-air car park on Wang Kwong Road. Furthermore, it was understood that the relevant management company would also step up cleaning of the car park.

10.3 FEHD would contact the relevant stakeholders of Tsui Ping (North) Estate to provide professional advice and technical support on mosquito prevention and control.

11. The representative of the Housing Department ("HD") stated that, in view of recent Chikungunya fever cases in the district, HD had stepped up mosquito control work in its public

housing estates and conducted joint operations with the relevant departments, including FEHD, to reduce vector risks.

12. Members raised further views and enquiries as follows:
 - 12.1 Members enquired how FEHD handled complaints regarding the hygiene of portable toilets.
 - 12.2 Members urged FEHD to follow up on the suspected sewage seepage issue near the minibus stand on Fuk Tong Road.
13. The representative of FEHD responded to Members' views and enquiries as follows:
 - 13.1 Complaints about portable toilets: FEHD would handle the matter according to the management responsibility for the toilets. If the toilets fell under the purview of a government department, the cases would be referred to the relevant department for follow-up. For private facilities, FEHD would follow up in accordance with the law and, where necessary, issue notices requiring the person-in-charge to clean the toilets.
 - 13.2 Seepage on Fuk Tong Road: FEHD had stepped up cleaning at the location and would continue to monitor the situation while conducting follow-up work with other departments.
14. Members noted the paper.

IV. Any Other Business

15. Members did not raise any other discussion items.

V. Date of Next Meeting

16. The next meeting was scheduled to be held at 2 p.m. on 18 November 2025 (Tuesday).
