### **Opening Remarks**

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the Food, Environment and Hygiene Committee (“FEHC”) and government representatives to the 12th meeting of FEHC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

#### **I. Confirmation of Minutes of Last Meeting**

2. Members had no further comments and the minutes of the 11th meeting were confirmed.

#### **II. Community Green Ambassador Scheme of the Leisure and Cultural Services Department (“LCSD”)**

3. The Chairman introduced the details of the Community Green Ambassador Scheme.

4. The Chairman announced that three DC Members (Mr PANG Chi-sang, Mr KWAN Kin-wing, and Ms CHING Hoi-yan) had expressed interest in representing Kwun Tong District as Community Green Ambassadors.

5. As there was no limit on the number of nominees, the Chairman announced that FEHC would nominate the three DC Members to LCSD to serve as Community Green Ambassadors on behalf of KTDC, with their term lasting until December 2027.

6. Members noted the matter.

**III. Progress Report on Environmental Hygiene Issues by the Food and Environmental Hygiene Department (“FEHD”)  
(KTDC FEHC Paper No. 20/2025)**

7. The representative of FEHD presented the paper.

8. Members noted the paper.

**IV. Environmental Hygiene Problems in Kwun Tong District  
(KTDC FEHC Paper No. 21/2025)**

9. The Secretary presented the paper.

10. Members raised views and enquiries as follows:

10.1 Members urged FEHD and other relevant departments to follow up on the congregation of feral pigeons and illegal feeding on the hillside outside the Lok Wah Estate Community Centre.

10.2 Members pointed out that feral pigeons often flew at low altitude around Lok Wah Estate and Lower Ngau Tau Kok Estate and expressed concern about the potential impact on traffic safety in the vicinity.

10.3 Members commended FEHD for its active handling of the sewage leakage issue on Fuk Tong Road and hoped that the department would continue to follow up on the environmental hygiene issues arising from repair works at the adjacent building.

10.4 Members expressed concern about whether the reprovisioning works of the public toilet at Ling Nam Sun Tsuen could be completed as scheduled in the first quarter of 2026.

10.5 Members raised concern about the hygiene conditions of footbridges in the Sze Shun area, particularly those connecting Shun On Estate to On Tai Estate and Shun Lee Estate to the Shun Lee Tsuen Sports Centre, and enquired about FEHD’s cleaning arrangements for footbridges.

10.6 Members urged the relevant departments to step up enforcement against the illegal

feeding of feral pigeons and wild pigs around Pik Wan Road.

11. The representative of FEHD responded to Members' views and enquiries as follows:
  - 11.1 The department stated that it had previously taken joint action with the Agriculture, Fisheries and Conservation Department ("AFCD") against the congregation of feral pigeons on the hillside at Lok Wah Estate and would continue to monitor the situation and take appropriate action.
  - 11.2 The department indicated that it would closely monitor the sewage leakage situation on Fuk Tong Road and step up cleaning efforts when necessary to improve environmental hygiene.
  - 11.3 The department noted that it had maintained close communication with the Architectural Services Department, and the reprovisioning works of the public toilet at Ling Nam Sun Tsuen were expected to be completed as scheduled in the first quarter of 2026. The department would inform Members of any further updates.
  - 11.4 The department explained that FEHD was mainly responsible for general sweeping work on footbridges. When necessary, the department would refer the matter to the Highways Department for follow-up cleansing work based on the cleanliness of the footbridge surfaces.
  - 11.5 The department stated that if FEHD personnel found individuals littering public places while feeding animals, for example, by leaving residual feed on the ground, they may issue a fixed penalty notice of \$3,000 under the Fixed Penalty (Public Cleanliness and Obstruction) Ordinance. For repeat offenders, FEHD would institute prosecutions by way of summons. In areas where animal feeding was a serious problem, in addition to routine law enforcement operations, FEHD would also deploy Dedicated Enforcement Teams to carry out blitz prosecution actions so as to strengthen enforcement against littering of road surfaces caused by animal feeding in public places. The department would also coordinate with AFCD on animal management and enforcement efforts and, when necessary, arrange joint operations with AFCD.
12. The representative of the Environmental Protection Department stated that the repair works at Kwun Tong Mansion had been completed in November. The department had subsequently conducted site inspections at the minibus stop on Fuk Tong Road, but found no evidence of sewage leakage.
13. The Chairman summarised Members' views and (i) requested the Secretariat to provide the

contact information of AFCD law enforcement officers to all DC Members and FEHC Members after the meeting so that they could report feral pigeon nuisance cases in the district; and (ii) asked Members to provide the Secretariat with details of the aforementioned hygiene blackspots for follow-up.

14. Members noted the paper.

**V. Any Other Business**

15. The Chairman referred Members to the paper regarding the 2026 Lunar New Year Fair in Kwun Tong District.

16. The representative of FEHD presented the paper.

17. Members expressed concern about the impact of road closure measures for the event on residents of Tsui Ping Estate and suggested that FEHD announce road closure arrangements as early as possible so that Members could relay the information to affected residents.

18. The representative of FEHD responded that the department would notify Members of the road closure arrangements as early as possible and would also post notices near the venue in advance.

19. The Chairman invited the representative of the Kwun Tong District Office (“KTDO”) to introduce the Kwun Tong Night Bazaar.

20. The representative of KTDO introduced the event.

21. The Chairman encouraged Members to actively support and participate in Lunar New Year celebration activities in the district.

**VI. Date of Next Meeting**

22. The next meeting was scheduled to be held at 2:30 p.m. on 20 January 2026 (Tuesday).

23. There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 2:56 p.m.
