Opening Remarks

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the National Education Promotion Committee (“NEPC”) and government representatives to the 10th meeting of NEPC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

I. Confirmation of Minutes of Last Meeting

2. Members had no further comments or amendments and the minutes of the last meeting were confirmed.
3. The Chairman said that the Secretariat had received notices of absence from Mr Tony CHUN and Ms SO Kit-ling before the meeting. NEPC consented to the above two applications for absence due to their compliance with Order 64 (1) of the Kwun Tong District Council Standing Orders.

II. School Activities Introducing Guangxi’s Intangible Cultural Heritage

4. The representatives of the Hong Kong Federation of Guangxi Clansmen Associations (“the Federation”) introduced the background and main activities of the Federation, as well as its experience

in promoting Guangxi's intangible cultural heritage in the community.

5. Members enquired whether the Federation would be interested in collaborating with schools and local organisations in Kwun Tong District to organise activities.
6. The representative of the Federation responded that the Federation could provide workshop material packages to schools and organisations, and arrange for instructors to participate in the activities.
7. Members hoped that the Federation would create more exchange opportunities for students from Hong Kong and Guangxi.
8. The representative of the Federation stated that the Federation organised annual exchange tours to Guangxi to enable Hong Kong students to gain a deeper understanding of Guangxi.
9. Members noted the agenda item.

III. Report on National Education Promotional Activities by Kwun Tong and Sau Mau Ping Police Districts
(KTDC NEPC Paper No. 2/2025)

10. The representative of the Hong Kong Police Force ("HKPF") presented the paper.
11. Members enquired about the schedule for the National Security Promotional Truck to visit Kwun Tong District.
12. The representative of HKPF stated that the police's preliminary plan was to arrange for the Promotional Truck to be parked at Kwun Tong Promenade on 28 September.

IV. Activity for Promotion of National Education - The Fifth Anniversary of the Promulgation of the Hong Kong National Security Law - Kwun Tong District Youth National Security Learning Day

14. The representative of the Kwun Tong District Office indicated that the event had been

successfully held on 9 July 2025. The event featured a variety of activities, including arranging for secondary school students in the district to attend a cybersecurity talk and visit the Hong Kong Museum of the War of Resistance and Coastal Defence, with the aim of enhancing their understanding of the importance of national security.
