Opening Remarks

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the National Education Promotion Committee (“NEPC”) and government representatives to the 11th meeting of NEPC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

I. Confirmation of Minutes of Last Meeting

2. Members had no further comments or amendments and the minutes of the last meeting were confirmed.

II. Promoting National Education in Schools – Experience Sharing by Shun Tak Fraternal Association Leung Kit Wah Kindergarten

3. Dr NG Siu-ming, Principal of Shun Tak Fraternal Association Leung Kit Wah Kindergarten, shared the school’s experience in promoting national education, which included arranging student visits to the Patriotic Education Centre and organising Mainland exchange tours.

4. Members enquired about the role of parents in national education at the kindergarten level and expressed concern over whether the curriculum might be too complex for kindergarten students.

5. The representative of the Education Bureau (“EDB”) responded that the current Kindergarten Education Curriculum Guide included recommendations for implementing parent education for kindergartens’ reference. EDB also provided a one-off “Grant for Promotion of National Education through Home-school Co-operation” to kindergartens participating in the Kindergarten Education Scheme to support them in organising school-based parent education or parent-child activities related to national education.

6. Dr NG added that the kindergarten provided courses and workshops on parent education for parents. At the same time, national education knowledge was taught to students through games, role-playing, and examples from daily life.

7. Members noted the agenda item.

III. Activities for Promotion of National Education – “Spark Up East Kowloon – Celebrate

National Day Together” China-chic Cultural Celebration Events - China-chic Intangible Cultural Heritage (“ICH”)·ICH Craft Experience Fair and China-chic New Sounds · Youth Resonance

8. The representative of the Kwun Tong District Office stated that the abovementioned activities had been successfully held on 20, 21, and 27 September 2025, respectively. The events were rich in content, including bookmark-making, lantern workshops, and Chinese music performances, with the aim of promoting “China-chic” culture, ICH crafts and traditional Chinese music to the public, and enhancing their understanding of Chinese culture.

9. Members noted the agenda item.

IV. Any Other Business

10. Members provided views on the activity “District Council Members’ School Outreach to Promote National Education” and proposed organising diversified activities to enable students to gain a deeper understanding of the work of DC Members.
