Opening Remarks

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the National Education Promotion Committee (“NEPC”) and government representatives to the 13th meeting of NEPC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

2. The Chairman said that the Secretariat had received notices of absence from Mr TAM Siu-cheuk and Mr NG Sing-wah before the meeting. NEPC consented to the above two applications for absence due to their compliance with Order 64 (1) of the Kwun Tong District Council Standing Orders.

I. Confirmation of Minutes of Last Meeting

3. Members had no further comments or amendments, and the minutes of the last meeting were confirmed.

II. Promoting National Education in Schools – Experience Sharing by Society of Boys’ Centres Shing Tak Centre School

4. Mr FUNG Kwong-chi, Principal of Society of Boys’ Centres Shing Tak Centre School (“STCS”), shared the school’s experience in promoting national education, including forming a flag-raising team, holding Chinese cultural experiential activities, and arranging Mainland exchange tours.

5. Members raised views and enquiries as follows:

5.1 Members were concerned about how STCS followed up on the mental health conditions of different students.

5.2 Members suggested that STCS could arrange for students to participate in community activities, such as flag-raising ceremonies, to enhance their self-confidence and sense of belonging to the community and the nation.

6. Principal FUNG responded to Members’ views and enquiries as follows:

6.1 STCS would work with a multi-disciplinary team consisting of social workers, educational psychologists, and clinical psychologists to assess students' conditions on a continuous basis. Class teachers would also accompany students to follow-up consultations and report their conditions to doctors to assist in adjusting treatment plans.

6.2 STCS had been actively arranging for students to participate in various community activities, such as volunteer work and inter-school exchange programmes. Principal FUNG thanked Members for their views and expressed that the potential for collaboration could be explored.

7. The Chairman commended Principal FUNG and his team for their efforts and expressed the hope that NEPC would strengthen exchanges and cooperation with STCS in the future in areas such as community activities and national education.

8. Members noted the agenda item.

III. Activities for Promotion of National Education – “Law by Your Side • Kwun Tong Civic Education Day”

9. The representative of the Kwun Tong District Office indicated that the above event had been successfully held on 24 January 2026. The event featured a wide range of activities, including an exhibition themed around the Constitution and the Basic Law, booth games, stage performances, and a mini electric vehicle experience zone. These activities aimed to enhance public understanding of the Constitution and the Basic Law while promoting the concept of green living.

10. Members noted the agenda item.
