## **Opening Remarks**

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the National Education Promotion Committee (“NEPC”) and government representatives to the 2nd meeting of NEPC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

### **I. Confirmation of Minutes of Last Meeting**

2. Members had no further comments or amendments and the minutes of the first meeting were confirmed.

### **II. Sharing on Information Technology Security and Cyber Security**

3. Professor WONG gave a briefing on the status and development of information technology and cyber security in Hong Kong.

4. Members were concerned about the existing risks in Hong Kong’s information security, the lack of relevant talented professionals and the Government’s inadequate attention to related matters.

5. Members mentioned the sudden breakdown in the computer system during last year’s District Council Election, and expressed concern about whether it was due to cyber security vulnerabilities.

6. Professor WONG said that at the design stage of computer systems, emergency plans were generally prepared at the same time to provide immediate remedies in the event of incidents.

7. Members enquired whether there was any existing legislation regulating the collection of

personal data by mobile applications.

8. Professor WONG stated that applications would obtain user consent before collection of personal data but reminded the public to pay attention to the terms and conditions.

9. Members believed that students should receive cyber security education from an early age to enhance their understanding in this area.

### **III. Any Other Business**

10. Members did not raise any other business.

### **IV. Date of Next Meeting**

11. The next meeting was scheduled to be held on 30 May 2024 (Thursday).

12. There being no other business, the meeting was adjourned at 3:40 p.m.
