Opening Remarks

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the National Education Promotion Committee (“NEPC”) and government representatives to the 4th meeting of NEPC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

I. Confirmation of Minutes of Last Meeting

2. Members had no further comments or amendments and the minutes of the third meeting were confirmed.

II. Report on National Education Promotional Activities by Kwun Tong and Sau Mau Ping Police Districts (KTDC NEPC Paper No. 2/2024)

3. The representative of the Hong Kong Police Force (“HKPF”) presented the paper.

4. Members raised views and enquiries as follows:

4.1 Members suggested organising a cooking competition themed on Chinese cuisine to promote the broad and profound Chinese food culture.

4.2 Members shared their experience of participating in an exchange tour to Guizhou and opined that exchange tours could help young people learn about the culture and history of their motherland.

5. The Chairman enquired about the details of “Mission in Prison” mentioned in the paper.
6. The representative of HKPF responded to Members’ views and enquiries as follows:
 - 6.1 HKPF said that it would relay the views regarding the cooking competition to the department.
 - 6.2 HKPF explained that “Mission in Prison” mentioned in the paper was a one-day tour co-organised with secondary schools, allowing young people to understand the serious consequences of committing crimes through visiting correctional facilities and experiencing prison life, thereby strengthening their law-abiding awareness.
 - 6.3 HKPF encouraged youths to join the Junior Police Call and participate in various training activities to become crime-fighting partners of HKPF.
7. Members noted the paper.

III. National Education Activity: Exhibition cum Community Prize-winning Game in Celebration of the 27th Anniversary of Hong Kong’s Reunification with China

8. The Chairman informed Members that the event was successfully held from 6 to 10 July, featuring an exhibition celebrating Hong Kong’s reunification with the Motherland and AI games promoting national education.
9. Members raised views and enquiries as follows:
 - 9.1 Members enquired whether more similar National Day celebration activities would be organised.
 - 9.2 Members suggested organising more national education activities for grassroots children.
10. The Chairman thanked Members for supporting the activity and looked forward to continuing to collaborate with all parties to organise more events in the future.
11. Assistant District Officer (Kwun Tong)² said that the Kwun Tong District Office would soon organise a number of large-scale National Day celebration activities and called for Members’

enthusiastic support.
