Opening Remarks

The Chairman welcomed all Members of the National Education Promotion Committee (“NEPC”) and government representatives to the 6th meeting of NEPC under the 7th Term Kwun Tong District Council (“KTDC”).

2. The Chairman said that the Secretariat had received a notice of absence from Mr NG Ting-fung before the meeting. NEPC consented to the above application for absence due to its compliance with Order 64 (1) of the Kwun Tong District Council Standing Orders.

I. Confirmation of Minutes of Last Meeting

3. Members had no further comments or amendments and the minutes of the last meeting were confirmed.

II. Sharing by Kwun Tong Schools Liaison Committee – “Celebrating the 75th Anniversary of the Founding of the People’s Republic of China: Kwun Tong District Schools’ Study Tour to Ganzhou, Jiangxi”

4. Principal CHEUNG shared his experience of visiting Ganzhou, Jiangxi Province, with members

of the education sector from Kwun Tong District to learn about the local history and culture and exchange ideas on patriotic education.

5. The representative of the Kwun Tong District Office (“KTDO”) opined that the study tour was very meaningful and indicated that the experience could serve as a reference for organising similar activities in the future.

6. Principal CHEUNG responded that the successful completion of the study tour was attributed to the participating teachers, who arranged an extensive patriotic education itinerary.

III. Report on National Education Promotional Activities by Kwun Tong and Sau Mau Ping Police Districts
(KTDC NEPC Paper No. 3/2024)

7. The representative of the Hong Kong Police Force (“HKPF”) presented the paper.

8. Members raised views and enquiries as follows:

8.1 Members enquired about the details of the “Positive Life Art Workshop”.

8.2 Members commended the police for actively organising national education activities and suggested that other disciplined services could also hold more relevant activities.

9. The Chairman enquired about the model of cooperation between police districts and schools’ flag-raising teams.

10. The representative of HKPF responded to Members’ views and enquiries as follows:

10.1 HKPF said that the “Positive Life Art Workshop” was hosted by illustrator Littleink, who helped participants develop positive thinking through teaching them how to draw.

10.2 HKPF indicated that it would directly contact schools and arrange relevant activities through the flag-raising training programme.

11. Members noted the paper.

IV. Activities for Promotion of National Education: “Honouring China · Spreading Love - Exhibition of Chinese Wedding Traditions in Celebration of the 75th Anniversary of the Founding of the People’s Republic of China in Kwun Tong District”

12. The representative of KTDO said that the event, successfully held from 12 to 14 October 2024, featured a diverse range of activities. In addition to an exhibition of wedding attire and ceremonial items from different eras, the event included a tea culture sharing session, which enabled the public to learn about the traditional customs of wedding ceremonies. Two experts with in-depth knowledge of wedding culture were also invited to explain traditional Chinese wedding rituals and Hong Kong-style wedding culture to participants. KTDO extended its gratitude to Members for their support of the event.
