II. Sharing by the Academy of Chinese Studies on Promoting National Education in Schools and the Community

3. The representative of the Academy of Chinese Studies (“ACS”) introduced the background of ACS and its work in promoting Chinese culture in schools and the community. This year, ACS would actively organise activities commemorating the 80th anniversary of victory in the War of Resistance.

4. Members enquired whether ACS would collaborate with local organisations to organise activities.

5. The Chairman hoped that ACS would provide Members with resources such as teaching materials

and videos for use in national education activities.

6. The representative of ACS replied that ACS had been producing teaching materials for free use by primary and secondary schools. Members interested in using the teaching materials were welcome to contact ACS. In addition, the representative of ACS indicated that the Academy would consider co-organising seminars or workshops with Members or local organisations on specific themes.

7. The Vice-chairman suggested incorporating elements of the country's successful development in various fields into the teaching materials, believing that this would provide greater inspiration for students.

8. The representative of ACS replied that they would produce videos and teaching materials on novel topics to enhance students' interest.
